MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 18TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1949, AT 1:30 P.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence of Directors as follows:

#### PRESENT

Joe B. Hogsett Houston Hill Dan H. Priest Gaylord J. Stone W. L. Pier

Also present were Sidney L. Samuels, General Attorney, and C. L. McNair, General Manager.

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as president, and Director Priest acted in his capacity as secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

The Directors had previously received copies of a Regular Meeting held on December 29, 1948, at 2:30 P.M. Having found no objections thereto, it was ordered that they be approved, signed and placed of record.

2.

There was laid before the Directors the official returns of the election for Directors held in the District on January 11, 1949, to determine who should be chosen to serve as Directors to succeed the expiring terms of Directors Joe B. Hogsett and Dan H. Priest. Thereupon, all the Directors, as a Committee of the Whole, publicly opened, examined and did canvass the returns thereof. From the tabulation the Directors find and do now here declare that the following named candidates received total votes as follows:

OUT OF THE 145 VOTES CAST IN SAID ELECTION.

Joe B. Hogsett received 145 votes
Dan H. Priest received 142 votes
George Bevel, Jr. received 1 vote

Therefore, it is hereby declared that the said Joe B. Hogsett and Dan H. Priest have been duly elected as Directors to serve the District for the period of two years or until their successors may have been duly elected and qualified.

Immediately upon the canvassing of said returns and the declaration of the result of the said election, Directors Joe b. Hogsett and Dan H. Priest qualified by making and taking Statutory Oaths of Office and presenting their respective Statutory Official Bonds. Upon examination of said instruments, and having advice of Sidney L. Samuels, General Counsel, that they were in legal form, Director Stone moved, seconded by Director Hill, that the bonds of each of said Directors be received and approved as good and sufficient, and that each of said persons so elected and chosen by the voters as aforesaid, be and they are hereby recognized, constituted and established to serve as Directors for the District for the term hereinbefore designated; further that the bonds do be recorded in the official bond records of Tarrant County and that thereafter they be preserved as records of this District in a manner conforming to law.

Further, that the said election returns, together with the tabulation thereof and the oaths of office and official bonds of the said Directors be attached to these Minutes in Folio as Exhibit "A". It was so ordered.

3.

Thereupon President Hogsett stated that it was now in order to select officers for the District to serve the year to come; whereupon

Director Stone moved, seconded by Director Pier, that the officers to serve the District for the current year be, as follows: For President, Joe B. Hogsett; for Vice-President, Houston Hill, and for Secretary, Dan H. Priest. Upon a vote being taken all Directors voted for the motion and no Director voted against it; whereupon the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

4.

President Hogsett then stated that he would appoint committees for the ensuing year to be as follows:

#### LAND MATTERS

Dan H. Priest Gaylord J. Stone Houston Hill

This committee, with the assistance and advice of the General Manager and General Attorney of the Board, shall have charge of all activities pertaining to the acquiring, selling, leasing and general management of lands belonging to the District.

#### LEGAL AND FINANCIAL

W. L. Pier Joe B. Hogsett Dan H. Priest

This committee, with the assistance and advice of the General Manager and General Attorney of the Board, shall have charge of all legal and financial matters of the District.

#### ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS.

Gaylord J. Stone Houston Hill Dan H. Priest

This committee, with the assistance and advice of the General Manager and General Attorney of the Board, shall have charge of all activities pertaining to engineering and construction contracts.

#### OFFICE ORGANIZATION

Houston Hill Dan H. Priest W. L. Pier

This committee, with the assistance and advice of the General Manager, and General Attorney of the Board, shall have charge of all matters pertaining to assessing and collecting District Taxes, as well as all matters pertaining to the office. It was so ordered.

#### CUSTODIAN OF SECURITIES.

It was moved, seconded and carried by unanimous vote of the Board, that Mr. Joe B. Hogsett, President of the Board, should act for the District, as Custodian of collateral securities delivered to the District, by the District's Depository, as pledge in lieu of other bonds to secure deposits of this District, as set out in the executed Depository Bond and Contract for pledge of collateral security, between the Depository and the District.

It was also unanimously resolved and carried that in the event of the inability of Mr. Hogsett to serve, or should he be absent from the city at any such time, Mr. Dan H. Priest, one of the Directors of the Board, should be alternate, and act in his stead.

5.

Attached to these Minutes as Exhibit "B", is a statement of the financial condition of this District to which reference is made. Exhibit "B" shows that interim voucher-checks #589 to #619, inclusive, for the total sum \$4,800.69, had been issued since the last meeting; also proposed voucher-checks #620 to #631, inclusive, for the total sum \$1,061.34. There was full consideration of the proposed voucher-checks and the data to support same, whereupon Director Hill moved, seconded by Director Stone, that the issued voucher-checks above listed be confirmed, and that the accounts payable be approved as covered by

the proposed voucher-checks and that such checks be issued and delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive them. ordered, subject to the usual audit.

6.

The written report dated January 18, 1949, of Mr. C. L. McNair, for the month of December, 1948, was received, presented and ordered filed as Exhibit "C" to these Minutes.

7.

Mr. McNair presented certain proposals for lease of District's lands for the year 1949, which he recommended for approval, as follows:

Upon consideration of each of the above lease proposals, Director Pier moved, seconded by Director Stone, that the said proposals be approved and closed in the usual manner, subject to the payment of the agreed rentals and execution of written contracts in the form required by the District. It was so ordered. #15 ' Mr. McNair then presented a proposal from Mr. L. W.

Matthews for the renewal of his land lease for the year 1949, together with a written request from Mr. Matthews, asking approval of the Board for the transfer and assignment of this land lease to Mr. A.

C. McKenzie, which Mr. McNair recommended for approval. Thereupon, Director Stone moved, seconded by Director Pier, that Mr. Matthews! proposal for renewal of his lease for 1949, and the transfer and assignment of the lease to Mr. A. C. McKenzie be approved, subject to the payment of the agreed rental and execution of written contract in the form required by the District, and the written acceptance of the lease by Mr. McKenzie. It was so ordered.

9.

The Board then took up and considered a communication in writing dated January 13, 1949, from Jean Harris, Clerk of the Commissioners' Court of Tarrant County, Texas, setting out that the Commissioners' Court of Tarrant County had requested that the compensation to be paid by Tarrant County Water Control and Improvement District Number One for the assessment and collection of taxes by the Tax Assessor and Collector of Tarrant County for the two-year period, beginning January 1, 1949, be fixed at \$3,300.00 per annum.

The clerk enclosed with such communication a Resolution copied from the Minutes of the Commissioners' Court of Tarrant County at a Regular Session held on January 13, 1949, in which the Commissioners' Court requested that the compensation so to be paid by Tarrant County Water Control and Improvement District Number One be increased to the maximum prescribed in Article 7880, Sec. 33, which maximum was and is \$3,300.00 per annum, and that the contract

proposed by the District make provision for such maximum compensation.

Upon consideration of such communication, it was moved by Director Hill, seconded by Director Stone, that the compensation to such Tax Assessor and Collector for said services for the full period of two years beginning January 1, 1949, and terminating at midnight of December 31, 1950, be increased to \$3,300.00 per annum, the maximum allowed by statutory law, and that the contract make provision for the payments to be made as follows:

The motion having been put to the Board, all the Directors voted "aye" thereon, and it was so ordered.

It was further ordered by the Board, that the attorneys for the District should see to it that the matter be arranged in conformity with the order of the Board.

10.

On motion of Director Priest, seconded by Director Stone, it was proposed that the District advertise its intention of leasing some parts of its lands, amounting to approximately 2579.55 acres situated in Jack County, Texas, for oil and gas purposes, and that bids be received for same from persons interested to bid thereon according to the terms of the advertisement.

Further that such advertisement should appear in two newspapers in general circulation; one of which to be published in Jack County, Texas, and the other in Tarrant County, Texas; that it should appear once a week for three successive weeks, according to the law in such cases made and provided.

The motion having been put to the meeting, the same was unanimously carried, all the Directors voting "aye" thereon.

11.

It having been brought to the attention of the Board that the time had come round for the selection of a banking depository for the District, it was ordered by the Board that advertisements for bids by banks desiring to serve in that capacity, should be published in the Fort Worth Ptar-Telegram and the Fort Worth Press, three times, to-wit: February 17; February 24, and March 3, 1949; in accordance with the law, and that bids in response to advertisements should be submitted to the Board on or before 1:00 P.M. March 7, 1949. A copy of such order is attached to these Minutes as Exhibit "D".

12.

There was presented to the Meeting a communication from Mr. George Williams, Director of Public Works of the town of River Oaks, adjacent to the City of Fort Worth, and a great portion of which said town lies within the boundaries of this District, inquiring whether or not it would be possible at some time in the future to make an arrangement with the authorities of the Town of River Oaks to supply such town with water for domestic purposes and for fire purposes. Such communication was read and considered by the Board: Thereupon, motion was made and seconded, that said Dir-

ector of Public Works be informed that the matter would receive due consideration when it became right for action, and that the Directors looked sympathetically upon the suggestion contained in the communication.

.13

Following the foregoing matter, a letter was presented to the Board from Mr. R. R. Lowdon, a citizen of the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, concerning the matter of a long-term lease on lands adjacent to Eagle Mountain Lake. On motion of Director Hill, seconded by Director Pier, the communication was referred to the land committee to make investigation and report thereon in the near future. The motion was unanimously adopted, and it was so ordered.

There being no further business before the Board, the Meeting thereupon adjourned.

REPORT FOR DECEMBER, 1948.

Gentlemen:

We were engaged in work pertaining to the Gasperson damage suit against the District during most of December.

On Thursday, December 30th, Mr. W. A. Nelson of Jacksboro went with Mr. Hutcheson and me over the lands he has under lease. We found grazing conditions very poor due to the prolonged drouth. Approximately fifty head of livestock were on the premises.

On December 31st, Mr. George Williams, Director of Public Works for the City of River Oaks, called at this office and discussed with me the possibility of obtaining water from the District, for municipal purposes. The greater part of the City of River Oaks is within the boundaries of this District. Water could be delivered to a point in the river channel near their city limits.

During December, water released into Lake Worth, and natural losses, amounted to 4,200 acre feet.

Total storage in both lakes on December 31, 1948, was 260,800 acre feet.

Total rainfall recorded for the year 1948, at Eagle Mountain Lake was 20.11 inches, and 21.21 inches at Lake Bridgeport.
