MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 7TH DAY OF JULY, 1953, AT 1:30 P.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of Directors, as follows:

Also present were Messrs. Sidney L. Samuels, General Counsel of the District, C. L. McNair, General Manager of the District, and Marvin C. Nichols, of the firm of Freese and Nichols, consulting engineers for the District.

Director Hill acted as President in the absence of Director Hogsett, and Director Priest acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done, as follows:

1.

The Directors had previously received copies of the Minutes of June 30, 1953, at 1:30 P.M., and having found no objections thereto, it was ordered that they be approved, signed and placed on record.

2.

Attached to these minutes as Exhibit "A" is a statement of the financial condition of this District to which reference is made. Exhibit "A" shows that proposed voucher-checks #3976 to #4063, inclusive, had been issued for the total sum \$105,326.74.

There was full consideration of the proposed voucher-checks and the data to support same, whereupon Director Priest moved, seconded by Director Pier, that the issued voucher-checks above listed be confirmed, and that the accounts payable be approved as covered by the proposed voucher-checks, and that such checks be issued and delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive them. It was so ordered, subject to the usual audit.

3•

The subject of exchange of lands between the District and the Federal Government concerning which a proposition to that effect had been submitted to the Federal Government was again presented to the meeting, and it was the unanimous sense of the Board that since the time for such action under the terms of the proposition submitted to the Federal Government by the District had expired, that an extension should be granted in view of the Act of Congress authorizing such exchange. Accordingly, since such extension agreement had been prepared at a prior meeting in which the President and the Secretary of the Board had been authorized to execute the Articles of Extension, it was moved by Director Pier, seconded by Director Priest, that the action of the President and Secretary in executing such extension agreement be ratified and approved and also in transmitting such extension agreement to the Commandant of the Eighth Naval District at New Orleans, Louisana, to be in turn transmitted by him to the proper authorities in Washington, D. C.

Mr. Hickey, Land Agent of the District, suggested that the time was now ripe for determining the proposition heretofore submitted by Mr. Mickey Schmid, representing North Texas Advertising Company, for the placing of signs on District property.

Mr. Hickey further observed that the localities for such signs had been investigated and that the matter should be disposed of at a future meeting of the Board, with Mr. Schmid to be present for conference.

It was thereupon, moved and seconded, that Mr. Schmid be invited to be present at a subsequent meeting, and that then the matter be taken up, and if practicable, the terms of a contract be arranged. All the Directors present voted "aye" thereon.

5.

Mr. Marvin C. Nichols represented to the Boærd that in his judgment we should keep the engagement heretofore made with the State Board of Water Engineers at Austin, on Wednesday the 8th of July, 1953, and to confer with such Board concerning the amendments to Permit No. 1074, for Eagle Mountain Lake, and that the three who should proceed to Austin, should include Messrs. Houston Hill, Marvin C. Nichols and Sidney L. Samuels. It was accordingly so ordered, with instruction to prepare for the trip on the day following this meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting thereupon adjourned.

In addition to the \$1,050,000.00 United States Securities mentioned, the Interest and Sinking Fund also owns Twelve (12) Vendor's Lien Promissory Notes of J. D. Craft, bearing date of July 1, 1952, aggregating the sum \$60,000.00; each of said notes being in the principal sum of \$5,000.00, with interest thereon at 4% per annum, payable annually at the office of the District in Fort Worth, Texas, said twelve notes maturing on or before nine, ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty years.
