Also present were Messrs. John M. Scott of the legal staff of the District, C. L. McNair, General Manager of the District, and Joe B. Mapes of the engineering firm of Freese and Nichols, consulting engineers of the District.

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President, and Director Priest acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

The Directors had previously received copies of the minutes of the following meetings:

Having found no objections to the minutes of the above dates, it was ordered that they be approved, signed and placed on record.

Attached to these minutes as Exhibit "A" is a statement of the financial condition of this District to which reference is made, Exhibit "A" shows that interim voucher-checks #4371 to #4504,

inclusive, for the total sum of \$138,400.02 had been issued since the last meeting. There was full consideration of the proposed voucher-checks and the data to support same, whereupon Director Priest moved, seconded by Director Seymour, that the issued voucher-checks above listed be confirmed, and that the accounts payable be approved, as covered by the proposed voucher-checks; that such checks be issued and delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive them. It was so ordered, subject to the usual audit.

Mr. Ben F. Hickey, Land Agent, for the District, presented for the consideration of the Board, a contract for the acquisition of lands for floodway purposes, as follows:

Lot No. 12, in Block No. 2, Brookside Annex to the City of Fort Worth, Tarrant County, Texas, and all improvements located thereon, of which O. K. Locke and wife, Beulah Locke, are sellers. The consideration of the sale is \$6,890.50, to be paid by the District, and title insurance to be procured through Fort Worth and Tarrant County Abstract Company of Fort Worth, Texas. The contract was signed by the sellers, O. K. Locke and wife, Beulah Locke, and for the District by Houston Hill, and dated October 15, 1953.

On motion of Director Hill, seconded by Director Priest, said contract was ratified with instructions that upon completion of the same by deed of conveyance duly executed and acknowledged by the vendor and title policy issued in such case, that voucheracheck be drawn to cover the transaction and be delivered to the sellers when the trade has been completed. All the Directors voted "aye" thereon.

Mr. McNair presented certain proposals for lease of District's lands for the year 1953, which he recommended for approval, as follows:

Upon consideration of each of the above lease proposals, Director Hill moved, seconded by Director Pier, that the said lease proposals be approved and closed in the usual manner, subject to the payment of the agreed rentals and execution of written contracts in the form required by the District. There was read before the Board, in response to invitation from Mr. Hogsett, the President, a communication in writing under date of October 15, 1953, from Sidney L. Samuels to the District concerning the possibility of any claim to be set up by the Federal Government for the use of properties owned by the District as a recreation camp and what was then termed as the CCC Camp.

The letter from the Counsel stated in effect that the Federal Government had not claimed nor had it ever at any time received any conveyance of the property from the District, and that it was a mere temporary expediency that was then formed, and inasmuch as the camp had been abandoned, no claim could arise thereon by the Federal Government. It was ordered that the letter be placed among the archives of the District.

There being no further business before the Board, the meeting thereupon adjourned.

Craft, bearing date of July 1, 1952, aggregating the sum \$55,000.00; each of said notes being in the principal sum of \$5,000.00, with interest thereon at 4% per annum, payable annually at the office of the District in Fort Worth, Texas, said eleven notes maturing on or before ten, eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty years.
