This letter in substance (which is attached in folio to these minutes and made a part thereof) was as follows: the letter was written on the letterhead of Freese and Nichols, consulting engineers, dated October 14, 1954, addressed to the Board of Directors of the District, and reads as follows:

"We are familiar with and have examined the proposed lease for oil and gas in the Bridgeport Lake. Prior to the advertisement for bids for tenders on an oil and gas lease covering some 12,000 acres in the Bridgeport Lake and contiguous area, the question of the effect of oil and gas operations on the water supply which is withdrawn from time to time from Lake Bridgeport was discussed by the Board with us.

During the earlier discussion of the proposed oil and gas lease we advised the Board that in our opinion oil and gas operations in the Bridgeport Lake would have no adverse effect on the water supply.
