MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 25TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1955, AT 2:30 P. M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of the Directors as follows:

Also present were Messrs. Sidney L. Samuels, General Counsel of the District; Ben F. Hickey, General Manager of the District and Marvin C. Nichols, of the firm of Freese and Nichols, Consulting Engineers for the District. Mr. Robert Sansom and Mr. Fred Korth were present part of the meeting.

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President, and Director Boggess acted in his capacity as Secretary whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meetings of February 9, 1955 and February 15, 1955 were read and approved by the Directors and ordered of record and it was accordingly so declared and all Directors voted age thereon.

2.

On motion of Director Hill, seconded by Director Boggess, voucher-checks #6290 to #6344, inclusive, were approved, having theretofore received the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes is the

Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors voted aye thereon.

3.

On motion of Director Hill, seconded by Director Boggess, Mr. Ben F. Hickey, General Manager of the District, was authorized to purchase from Ernest Allen Motor Company, on their low bid, a certain Truck at and for the price of \$2,218.43, and that vouchercheck by issued therefor in payment of same. The said Truck was needed and requested in Maintenance work at Eagle Mountain Lake. All the Directors present voted aye thereon.

4.

The matter of construction of a Dam on Marine Creek, which forms a part of Program "B" to shield property from the effects of floods and freshet was then taken up; after considerable round-table discussion of the subject from the members of the Board, it was moved by Director Pier, seconded by Director Hill that one Dam be erected and the site of same be known and designated as the "Trinity Site", and designated on the map and plat of same prepared by the Engineers for the District, as per their letter recommending such action, as attached hereto. All the Directors present voted aye thereon.

5.

After passing of the foregoing motion concerning construction of the one Dam, known as the "Trinity" Site, the Board also authorized the construction of the Dam known as "Cement Creek" Site. All Director voting aye thereon.



After considerable discussion, Mr. Hickey, as Land Agent for the District, was authorized to pay to the Beall Estate, on the basis of \$750.00 per acre for the land needed on Cement Creek Site; taking into consideration the appraisals made by Mr. Ed Corbett and Mr. H. H. Morse, well known and reliable judges of land values in and about Fort Worth. All the Directors voting aye thereon, save and except Mr. Seymour, who voted ney. Mr. Hickey was also instructed to proceed with the acquisition of other lands needed for the "Cement Creek" Site.
