On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting of July 30, 1956 were read and approved by the Directors present and it was accordingly so ordered.

On motion of Director Boggess, seconded by Director Hill, voucher-checks #8514 to #8589, inclusive, were approved and ordered filed, having theretofore received the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes

is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors present voted aye thereon.

President Hogsett presented to the Directors the Financial Report, for the month of July, 1956, as prepared by the County Auditor, in compliance with the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, and proposed that the report be accepted and filed in District office. This being the unanimous opinion of the Board, it was so ordered, and the audit filed.

Mr. Ben Hickey, General Manager, presented a request from Cities Service Oil Company, for an easement over District owned lands in Wise and Jack Counties, for gas or oil pipeline, being more particularly described by metes and bounds on record in District Office, for the amount of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR per rod, making payment to the District, the sum of THREE HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO (\$362.00) DOLLARS for pipeline easement over lands heretofore leased to Cities Service Oil Company. Director Hill moved that the easement as prepared by the Attorneys for the District be accepted, this was seconded by Director Boggess with all present voting aye thereon.
