On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held on February 12, 1958 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed of record.

President Hogsett presented to the Directors, the printed report as prepared by Freese and Nichols, Consulting Engineers, entitled "Report On Use Of Surplus Water Available From Proposed Ringgold Reservoir By Tarrant County District", and dated February

1958. It was the consenus of opinion of the Directors, and their order, that the report be received for study by the District.

There was held a general discussion pertaining to the first phases of study to be done by the firm of Wainwright and Ramsey, Inc., consulting financial advisors to the District for the proposed bond election and issuing to finance a future water supply for Fort Worth and Tarrant County, in view of the fact that Mr. Ramsey and Mr. McGill would report to the District on the morning of February 27, and would meet with the Directors at 10:30 A.M. on February 28 for the purpose of carrying forward the policy, as to be developed by the Directors of the District for plans of financing a future water supply.
