Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President, and Director Boggess acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held April 20, 1959 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly so ordered.

2.

On motion of Director Pier, seconded by Director Boggess, voucher-checks #13436 to #13510 inclusive, were approved and ordered paid, having theretofore received the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors voted aye thereon.

President Hogsett stated, that following the laws governing such matters, the District had now advertized it's intent to sell to the highest bidder, a tract of land in the Evans-Pearson-Westwood Addition, and more particularly described in the permanent files of the District, not now needed in the operation of the District and further stated that on May 6, 1959 a written appraisal from Mr. H. H. Morse, a recognized appraiser, stating his opinion as to the present day fair market value of the advertized tract; and following a discussion of the potential use of the land offered for sale and upon recommendation of management of the District, it was the unanimous opinion of the Directors and their order that no bid be considered for an amount less than \$6,500.00 for the tract as advertized.
