President Hogsett presented to the Directors an audit of the records of Wesco Stone Corporation pertaining to royalties due the District for rock and stone mined and sold from the 47.01 Acre Tract out of the Nicholas C. Butler Survey, Abstract No. 50 in Wise County, Texas for the period April 1, 1958 to March 31, 1959 made by Mr. Gordon G. Sheffield which was accepted and placed on file in the District's Records. Director Seymour moved that the invoice for making the audit, in the amount of \$544.04 be ordered paid, and being seconded by Mr. Hill, and approved by the Directors it was so ordered.

President Hogsett presented to the Directors copies of the notices of the hearing by the State Board of Water Engineers on the Application for Permit of the City of Houston and the Trinity River Authority numbers 2139 and 2140 to be held on Monday, November 2, 1959. Director Seymour requested that copies of the "Application for Permit" be obtained and distributed to the Directors and to Mr. Marvin Nichols and that Mr. Nichols be requested to review the applications and make a report to the Board.
