MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD ON THE 29TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1960 AT 11:00 A. M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presnece or absence of Directors as follows:

In the absence of President Hogsett, Vice-President Hill presided and Director Boggess acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held December 22, 1960 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

On motion of Director Boggess, seconded by Director Pier, voucher-checks #16854 to #16889 inclusive, for Program A and B, and voucher-checks #1495 to #1514 inclusive, for Program C, were approved and ordered paid, upon receiving the approval and verification of Mr.

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J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors present voted aye thereon.

3.

Vice-President Hill presented and read aloud a letter, dated December 22, 1960, addressed to the District from the Tarrant County Water Supply Corporation and signed by Mr. R. F. Richardson, which in substance made formal request of the District for the purchase of raw water to be taken by the Corporation at the Eagle Mountain Reservoir for the purpose of serving their customers in the Azle, Texas area, and estimated their requirements to be 500 gallons per Further request was made as to the rate schedule and any minute. other requirements necessary; whereon a resume of the contract with the City of Fort Worth was held, resulting in a lengthy detailed discussion of water sales and distribution, and in conclusion it was the consensus of opinion of the Directors and their order that management of the District consult with the Engineers and Attorneys for the District in the preparation of an answer to the Tarrant County Water Supply Corporation's request.

4.

Vice-President Hill requested Directors Boggess and Newton to act as a Committee, meeting with management of the District, to study the wage schedule of District employees, and make a report at

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the next meeting of the Board of Directors of their recommendations.

There being no further business before the Board of Directors, the meeting adjourned.
