MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD ON THE 15TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1962 AT 1:30 P. M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of Directors as follows:

PRESENT

Also present were Messrs. John M. Scott General Counsel for the District and Ben Hickey General Manager of the District.

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President and Director Boggess acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded the minutes of the meeting held January 30, 1962 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

On motion of Director Pier, seconded by Director Boggess, voucher-checks #748 to #784 inclusive, Cedar Creek Construction Fund; voucher-checks #977 to #1033 inclusive, Maintenance Fund ; voucherchecks #125 to #126 Cedar Creek Revenue Fund and voucher-check #120 Interest and Sinking Fund were approved and ordered paid upon receiving the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors voted aye thereon. #174

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President Hogsett reviewed briefly that the District had received on January 18, 1962, ten (10) bid (copies attached to these minutes) proposals, as requested by District, for the furnishing of gates and hoists as outlined in Contract No. 3 - Cedar Creek Spillway; and in substance stated that there were three (3) widely scattered bids for Sec. III (Automatic Gates), and that descriptive information submitted with the bid proposals was insufficient to permit evaluation and comparison of the bids received, and that additional detailed information was requested of each bidder.

Upon receipt of this information from each bidder, (copies attached hereto) comparison and evaluations were made by District and the Consulting Engineers for District, with a letter attached to these minutes and made a part hereto from said Engineers, Freese, Nichols and Endress dated February 12, 1962, which stated in substance that they recommend contracts be awarded as follows:

Following discussion, and upon recommendation of the Consulting Engineers for the District, as their attached letter, Director Hill seconded by Director Pier, made a motion that the above described bid proposals as submitted, be accepted, and that District execute Contracts for same upon approval of Council for District. All Directors voted aye thereon and it was so ordered.

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Mr. Ben Hickey, General Manager of the District, requested

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authority for the District to enter into Contract for the purchase of the following described tracts of land required for the Cedar Creek Reservoir, and on the following basis for payment, to-wit:

- (a) Tract No. 142 J. C. Moseley 90 acres @ Lump Sum \$10,000.00.
- (b) Tract No. 108 Mrs. Mary White 1/2 undivided interest in 80.01 acres more or less @ Lump Sum \$4,000.00.
- (c) Tract No. 108 Mr. W. H. White 1/2 undivided interest in 80.01 acres more or less @ Lump Sum \$4,000.00 (\$1,000.00 at closing and each succeeding anniversary date until paid).
- (d) Tract No. 280 Mrs. Juanita Wallower 26 acres more or less @ \$85.00 per acre.
- (e) Tract No. 117 F. O. Griffith 8.48 acres more or less @ \$100.00 per acre + \$160.00 Lump Sum for damages.
- (f) Tract No. 276 Dr. Leslie Kelton 30 acres more or less exchange for 5 acres of District owned land (Tract 122).
- (g) Tract No. 60 John M. Hamilton 98 acres more or less @ \$103.00 per acre, or not to exceed \$10,000.00 lump sum.
- (h) Tract No. 224 Mrs. C. A. White 1 acre more or less @ \$100.00 Lump Sum.
- (i) Tract No. 230 E. E. White 6.4 acres more or less
 @ \$100.00 per acre.
- (j) Tract No. 131 T. A. Taylor 5.02 acres more or less @ \$100.00 per acre.
- (k) Tract No. 279 Henry Hammons undivided 1/2 interest in 26.00 acres more or less on basis of \$85.00 per acre.
- (1) Tract No. 144 C. F. Everitt 4.99 acres more or less @ \$675.00 Lump Sum.

Following a detailed presentation of the Tracts, and upon recommendation of management of the District, Director Newton, seconded

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by Director Pier, moved that the District be authorized to enter into Contract for the purchase of the above described tracts and on the basis as shown. This meeting with the approval of all Directors, it was so ordered.
