MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD ON THE 14TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1963 AT 11:00 A.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of Directors as follows:

Also present were Messrs. Ardell Young General Counsel for the District and Ben Hickey General Manager of the District.

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President and Director Boggess acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held July 29, 1963 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

On motion of Director Boggess, seconded by Director Newton, voucher-checks #468 to #520 inclusive, Maintenance Fund; voucher-check #105, Interest and Sinking Fund; voucher-checks #103 to #106 inclusive, Construction Fund "A" and "B"; voucher-checks #732 to #784 inclusive, Cedar Creek Construction Fund and voucher-check #105 Revenue Fund were approved and ordered paid upon receiving the approval and verification of the County Auditor, Mr. J. M. Williams, who by virtue of the Statutes

is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors voted aye thereon.

3.

Mr.Ben Hickey, General Manager of the District, requested authority for the District to enter into Contract for the purchase of the following described tracts of land required for the Cedar Creek Reservoir, and on the following basis for payment, to-wit:

- (a) Tract No. 252 S. T. Dunn 34.14 acres more or less @ \$25.00 per acre flood easement.
- (b) Tract No. 174 Edna V. Stephens 25.51 acres more or less @ \$150.00 per acre.
- (c) Tract No. 47 & 47-A Haywood Wingham, et ux 39-88/100 acres more or less condemn.
- (d) Tract No. 82 A. A. Upchurch Estate \$200.00 amended damages due to taking.
- (e) Tract No. 207 E. W. Kennedy 20.87 acres more or less @ \$115.00 per acre.

Mr. Ben Hickey also requested authorization for the District to enter into Contract for the purchase of Pipeline Right-of-Way

Easements for the Cedar Creek Project, on the following basis for payment, to-wit:

- (a) Tract No. E-19-A P. L. Bryson 18.5 rods more or less @ \$4.00 per rod. Release of damages due to construction \$118.25.
- (b) Tract No. E-19 Ruby Bryson 31.2 rods more or less @ \$4.00 per rod. Release of damages due to construction of \$194.25.

Following a detailed presentation of the Tracts and Pipeline Right-of-way Easements, and upon recommendation of management of the District, Director Pier, seconded by Director Hill, moved that the District be authorized to enter into Contract for the purchase of the

above described tract and pipeline right-of-way easements and on the basis as shown. This meeting with the approval of all Directors, it was so ordered.
