On motion of Director Newton, seconded by Director Penry, voucher-checks #2222 to #2279 inclusive, Cedar Creek Construction; voucher-checks #2375 to #2434 inclusive, Maintenance Fund; voucher-checks #152 to #156 inclusive, Interest and Sinking Fund and voucher-checks #120 to #200 inclusive, Construction Fund were approved and ordered paid upon receiving the approval and verification of Mr.

J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well. All the Directors voted aye thereon.
