On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held April 14, 1967 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

On motion of Director Hudson, seconded by Director Penry, voucher-checks #4764 thru #4791 inclusive, Maintenance Fund; voucher-checks #1468 thru #1479 inclusive, Construction Fund; voucher-checks #667 thru #686 inclusive, Revenue Fund and voucher-check #226 Interest and Sinking Fund were approved and ordered paid upon receiving the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County Auditor, who

by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well.
All Directors present voted aye thereon.

President Hogsett presented the following letter, to-wit:

Following a discussion, and upon recommendation of management of the District, Director Penry made a motion, seconded by Director Hudson, that the bid of C. P. Hentzen, Inc. in the amount of \$27,890.00 be accepted. All Director present voted aye thereon.

President Hogsett presented a recommended request from management of the District for authority to purchase Tract No. E-47, fifteen (15) acres more or less in fee from Ernest H. Rice, et ux, for the right-of-way and pump station site for the Cedar Creek Pipeline, in the amount of \$12,000.00.

Following a discussion and review of the appraisal of the tract, Director Newton, seconded by Director Hudson, made a motion that Tract No. E-47 be purchased in fee at the recommended price of \$12,000.00. Upon a vote taken all Directors voted age and it was so ordered.

The following Tracts were recommended for prepayment of damages due to the proposed construction of the Cedar Creek Pipeline, and on the following basis, to-wit:

- (d) Tract No. E-98 Otto Macalik et ux 77 rods \$308.00.
- (e) Tract No. E-113 W. J. Vrla et ux 143-3/10 rods \$429.90.
- (f) Tract No. E-118 John Jaresh, et ux Grantor of Frank W. Holy, a single man 47-3/10 rods \$141.90.
- (g) Tract No. E-119 Josef Vrana et ux 155-2/10 rods \$465.60.
- (h) Tract No. E-21 Estate of J. D. Bryant 130 rods @ \$4.00 per rod plus prepayment of damages @ \$816.50.

Following a discussion of the recommendation for prepayment of damages on the above described tracts, Director Hudson made a motion, seconded by Director Penry, that the recommendation be approved. Upon a vote taken all Directors present voted age and it was so ordered.

Ben Hickey, General Manager of the District, presented a request from Mr. Jere Green et al, owner of a tract of land that will be required for the Flood Control Extension Program to the Dallas County line; and explained that Mr. Green had visited the District office many times inquiring as to the status of the District's acquisition program in his area.

Mr. Hickey stated that Tracts 3, 4 and 5 of the Loving

Survey - owned by Mr. Green were east of a location heretofore

established by the Directors as a point of termination of acquisition

at this time; however, it was pointed that Mr. Green now claims that

the fact that the land will be required for flood control purposes has and is placing a harship on him in his effort to sell or develop said land.

Following a general discussion, and review of appraisals presented of the said property, it was the decision of the Directors that Mr. Green be offered \$1,000.00 per acre for the land to be required as would be determined by a survey by the District.

There being no further business before the Board of Directors, the meeting adjourned.
