The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of Directors as follows:

Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President and Director Newton acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held April 2, 1968 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

On motion of Director Hudson, seconded by Director Penry, voucher-checks #5815 thru #5884 inclusive, Maintenance Fund; voucher-checks #1773 thru #1798 inclusive, Construction Fund; voucher-checks #1193 thru #1221 inclusive, Revenue Fund and voucher-check #252 and #253 Interest and Sinking Fund were approved and ordered paid upon receiving the approval and verification of Mr. J. M. Williams, County

Auditor who by virtue of the Statutes is the Auditor of this District as well. All Directors voted age thereon.

3.

Mr. Ben Hickey, General Manager of the District, requested authority for the District to enter into Contracts for the purchase of the following described tracts of land required for the Cedar Creek Pipeline and Program D - Clear Fork, on the following basis for payment, to wit:

- (a) Tract No. 3 Texas & Pacific Railway Company -54.06 acres more or less in fee at net cost to District of \$81,850.00 in cash and ll.5 acres more or less severed land purchased from K. W. Davis (Tract No. 27); 14.03 acres more or less in Easement @ \$9,750.00 - Program D, Clear Fork.
- (b) Tract No. 26 Colonial Country Club 41.6 acres more or less, in Easement - no cash for land -Contract Agreement - Program D, Clear Fork.
- (c) Tract No. 17 W. M. Calhoun et al 8.58 acres more or less in fee @ \$875.00 per acre - Cedar Creek Pipeline.

Following a lengthy detailed review of the above listed tracts, especially the Contract Agreement in Tract No. 26 - Colonial Country Club, and upon recommendation of Management and Counsel for the District, Director Boggess made a motion, seconded by Director Hudson, that the above listed tracts be purchased by the District at the prices and agreements as presented, copies of same attached to these minutes, upon a vote taken all Directors voted aye and it was so ordered.

President Hogsett reviewed the status of funds received

from the sale of lands now surplus to the needs of the District,

Program A and B, stating that General Counsel for the District had

advised the placing of said funds in the Maintenance Fund until

such time as they would be allocated, only by specific order of

the Directors, to the use as prescribed by the laws governing such

matters. Following a discussion of the matter, it was the unanimous

opinion of the Directors, and their order, that the above recommenda
tion be now in effect.
