Director Hogsett acted in his capacity as President, and Director Penry acted as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meetings held June 8 and 9, 1970 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

On motion of Director Penry, seconded by Director Hudson, voucher-checks #8648 thru #8681 inclusive, Maintenance Fund; voucher-checks #2595 thru #2603 inclusive, Construction Fund; voucher-checks #2193 thru #2203 inclusive, Revenue Fund and voucher-check #315 Interest and Sinking Fund were approved and ordered paid. All Directors voted aye thereon.

President Hogsett presented a copy of a letter from McCall, Parkhurst and Horton, Bond Counsel for the District, pertaining to the sale of District bonds within the limits of the net interest costs as set by law. Following a discussion it was the unanimous opinion of the Directors, and their order, that Mr. John M. Scott, General Counsel for the District begin the preliminary work required concerning the matter.

President Hogsett presented to the Directors for their consideration a recommended Preliminary Budget, by Management of the District, as required by the Trust Indenture, for the Cedar Creek Project and following a review Director Boggess made motion, seconded by Director Hudson, that the following preliminary budget be now adopted to wit:

There was presented to the Directors a projected statement of income and expense of the District for the year 1971; and following a detailed presentation of a recommended budget by management of the District, Director Penry made a motion, seconded by Director Boggess, that the current ad valorem tax rate of THIRTY-TWO (32¢) CENTS per \$100.00 valuation applicable to the properties within the taxing jurisdiction of the District, as placed on the tax rolls of Tarrant County by the Assessor-Collector, remain the same for the ensuing year 1971; and that the allocation of the revenues from said rate be allocated to wit: EIGHTEEN (18¢) CENTS to the Interest and Sinking Fund and FOURTEEN (14¢) CENTS to the Maintenance Fund. Upon a vote taken, all Directors voted aye and it was so ordered.

President Hogsett presented to the Directors the Monthly Financial Report regarding Receipts and Disbursements for Program "A", "B" and "D" and Cedar Creek Project, for the month of May, 1970 from the Auditor of the District, which was ordered accepted and placed in the District's Records.
