On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the Meeting held May 10, 1976 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

On motion of Director Penry, seconded by Director Thornton voucher-checks #17805 thru #17988 inclusive, Maintenance Fund in the amount of \$203,630.30; voucher-checks #4997 thru #5055 inclusive, Revenue Fund, in the amount of \$233,551.91; voucher-checks #3504 thru #3508 inclusive, Construction Fund, inthe amount of \$809,037.96; voucher-checks #526 thru #530 inclusive, Interest and Sinking Fund in the amount of \$3,278.99 and voucher-checks #4233 thru #4235 inclusive, Cedar Creek Construction Fund, in the amount of \$2,529.46

were approved and ordered paid. All Director present voted aye thereon.
