MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD ON THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH, 1977 AT 11:00 A.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of Directors as follows:

Director Newton acted in his capacity as President, and Director Shannon acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the meeting held February 28, 1977 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

2.

President Newton presented Messrs. Pope and Christie,
Attorneys from the law firm of Pope, Hardwicke, Christie, Montgomery
and Rehfelft, specialists in oil and gas matters, and asked that
they report their findings, and recommendations, to date regarding
the question of oil and gas royalties due the District as outlined

in certain oil and gas lease agreements heretofore described in the minutes of the Board of Director's meetings.

Whereon Mr. Pope reviewed in detail, and at great length, the history of the heretofore described oil and gas leases, assisted at times by Mr. Christie, and concluded by bringing the status of the matter to date, along with recommendations for consideration of the Directors of matters pertaining to the prosectuion of the matter.

Following a general and lengthy discussion by all parties,
Director Kyger made the motion, seconded by Director Penry and
unanimously approved, that upon the recommendations of Mr. Pope and
that of Ben Hickey, General Manager of the District and the approval
from Mr. John M. Scott, General Counsel for the District, who was
unable to attend this meeting because of court proceedings, that (1)
the District now revoke any and all division orders executed by the
District pertaining to the hereinabove referred to and described oil
and gas lease, including but not limited to, the following described
division orders, originally directed to Enserch predecessors, as well
as any prior or subsequent division orders pertaining to the units
and wells hereinbelow described and any and all other division orders,
affecting any part of the land as described in the assignments referred
to, whether specifically listed or not, to wit:

and further that the District expects to be paid in Fort Worth currently in accordance with the royalty provisions heretofore referred to in the leases of November 20, 1952 and October 18, 1954, together with interest at the appropriate rate for any delay in such payments; and that Enserch Corporation and Enserch Exploration, Inc. be so notified; (2) that the law firm of Pope, Hareicke, Christie,

Montgomery and Rehfeldt be now authorized to notify Enserch Corporation and Enserch Exploration, Inc. of their retainage by this District, and authority to request an immediate meeting with authorized Enserch personnel to discuss the matter and examine records pertaining to the matter; (3) that management of the District determine, prior to engaging the services of the recommended petroleum engineering firm of Gillespie and Assocaites, Inc., the costs of a preliminary study as required.

"Lone Star" matter, a review was given by Mr. Pope of the proposed action to be taken regarding George Mitchell and Associates, operators under the same basic lease as "Lone Star" and it was the concensus of all that the "Lone Star" matter be immediately instituted with the George Mitchell and Associates' royalty payment matter be carried on at the earliest possible date.
