Director Newton acted in his capacity as President and Director Shannon acted in his capacity as Secretary, whereupon proceedings were had and done as follows:

1.

On motion duly made and seconded, and with assurance from management that all requirements of law relating to the "open meeting" law had been met, the minutes of the meeting held September 27, 1978 were read and approved by the Directors and it was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

President Newton presented the following letter for consideration of the Directors, to wit:

Dear Mr. Hickey:

Bids were received on October 24, 1978, for furnishing certain equipment and materials to be used in the expansion of the Cedar Creek Lake Pump Station, pursuant to the Advertisement for Bids as published on October 2, 1978.

One bid was received for furnishing two Motor Controllers, from Westinghouse Electric Corporation in the total amount of \$2,573.00, and a proposed shipping time of 12 weeks. This equipment matches the existing Westinghouse Motor Control Center to which it will be attached, and we recommend a purchase order be given to them in accordance with their proposal and the pertinent specifications.

Two bids were received for furnishing 1,000 feet of 3/C 750 MCM Power Cable for station electrical service and motor leads as follows:

We recommend a purchase order be given to Cyprus Wire and Cable Company in accordance with their proposal and the pertinent specifications. The exact length of cable is to be determined by TCWCID prior to shipment.

⁽²⁾ Price firm except for metal escalation. Present base for copper, \$0.70625 per pound and for steel, \$0.188 per pound.

The bid of American Darling is the lowest and best bid received, and we recommend a purchase order be given to them in accordance with their proposal and the applicable specifications.

One bid was received for furnishing two (2) Air Handling and Cooling Units, from The Trane Company in the total amount of \$32,454.00, and a proposed shipping time of 16 to 18 weeks. We believe the price is in order and recommend a purchase order be given to them in accordance with their proposal and the pertinent specifications.
