With the recommendation of management, Director Henderson moved to authorize the District to pursue a pipe-to-soil survey to study cathodic protection alternatives on the Richland-Chambers and Cedar Creek pipelines, that Gifford-Hill-American's proposal dated May 2, 1989, be accepted with the exception that the survey be performed utilizing the District's equipment and further that staff pursue reduction of the proposed unit cost for

the survey due to the District purchasing the necessary equipment and providing additional manpower, however, with a unit cost not to exceed the proposed \$385.00 per mile. Director Sparks seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.
