With the recommendation of management, Director Geren moved to authorize the sale of 0.136 acre of land out of the John Mason Survey, A-526, Navarro County, Texas to the adjacent owner, Wilbur R. Ross, for \$1,800.00 subject to the reservation of a flowage easement between elevation 315 feet m.s.l. and 320 feet m.s.l., reservation of all minerals and is contingent upon the purchaser paying all closing costs including appraisal, surveying and title policy fees. R. Steve Christian shall be granted the authority to execute the deed and all other documents necessary to close the conveyance. Director Campbell seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With the recommendation of management, Director Geren moved to authorize the sale of 7.3 acres of land, more or less, out of the Sharp Whitley Survey, A-798, Henderson County, Texas to the winning bidder, E. O. Ashton, for the appraised value of \$1,200.00 per acre or \$8,760.00 and subject to the reservation of a flowage easement between elevation 322 feet m.s.l. and 325 feet m.s.l., reservation of all minerals, restricted to the development of a single family residence and is contingent upon the purchaser paying all closing costs including appraisal, surveying and title policy fees. R. Steve Christian shall be granted the authority to execute the deed and all other documents necessary to close the conveyance. Director Henderson seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With the recommendation of management, Director Henderson moved to authorize the purchase of two (2) telephone systems for Richland-Chambers and Fort Worth from United Telephone. A sum of \$45,761 will be provided from the General Fund to acquire the Fort Worth equipment and \$9,674 from the Revenue Fund to acquire the Richland-Chambers equipment. Director Geren seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With the recommendation of management, Director Campbell moved to approve the following list of vouchers for the month of September, 1992:
