On a motion made by Director Henderson and seconded by Director Puente, the Directors unanimously voted to approve the minutes from the meetings held June 12, 2003 and June 16, 2003. It was accordingly ordered that such minutes be placed in the permanent files of the District.

With the recommendation of management, Director Sparks moved to approve the purchase of a gooseneck/lowboy trailer for the low bid of \$72,556 submitted by Superior Trailer. Funding for this purchase is included in the FY 2003 General Fund Budget. Director Henderson seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With the recommendation of management, Director Newby moved to approve the sale of an encroachment described as 523 square feet, more or less, adjacent to Lot 29 on the Indian Oaks Subdivision at Cedar Creek Lake for the appraised value of \$1,490 to Mrs. Jackie Robertson. In addition, R. Steve Christian was granted authority to execute deeds and all other documents necessary to complete this conveyance. Director Sparks seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

With the recommendation of management, Director Newby moved to approve the appointment of Lindy Eubanks as Citizen Representative; and George Shannon, Victor Henderson, and Brian Newby of the Tarrant Regional Water District Board of Directors to the Trinity River Vision Leadership Council. Director Henderson seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.
