MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT HELD ON THE 15<sup>TH</sup> DAY AUGUST 2006 AT 9:30 A.M.

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The call of the roll disclosed the presence of the Directors as follows:

Also in attendance were George Christie, General Counsel for Tarrant Regional Water District (the Water District); Lee Christie representing Pope, Hardwicke, Christie, Schell, Kelly & Ray, LLP; Bill Marshall of Save Eagle Mountain Lake; Ken Hall of CH2M Hill; Max Baker representing Fort Worth Star Telegram; Earl Alexander and Elizabeth Olson.

President Henderson convened the meeting with the assurance from management that all requirements of the "open meetings" laws had been met.

1.

On a motion made by Director Stevens and seconded by Director Leonard, the Directors unanimously voted to approve the minutes from the meeting held July 18, 2006. It was accordingly ordered that these minutes be placed in the permanent files of Tarrant Regional Water District.

2.

There were no persons of the general public requesting the opportunity to address the Board of Directors.

Director Leonard inquired about saying the Pledge of Allegiance before each meeting.

With the recommendation of management, Director Stevens moved to allocate \$50,000 for the graphic production of advertising to be placed on Fort Worth Transit Authority buses and benches. Funding for this contract is included in the FY 2006 Revenue Fund Budget. Director Leonard seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

4.

With the recommendation of management, Director Sparks moved to place a proposal to adopt a 2006 tax rate of \$.02/\$100 on the agenda of the September 2006 Board of Directors meeting and establish the date for a public hearing on the proposed tax rate of \$.02/\$100 no less than three and no more than fourteen days prior to the September Board of Directors meeting Director Leonard seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

5.

With the recommendation of management, Director Leonard moved to approve a contract to overlay roofs at the Richland-Chambers Reservoir compound with a cool seal roofing system for the low bid of \$24,500 submitted by LSI Construction. Funding for this contract is included in the FY 2006 Revenue Fund Budget. Director Lane seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

6.

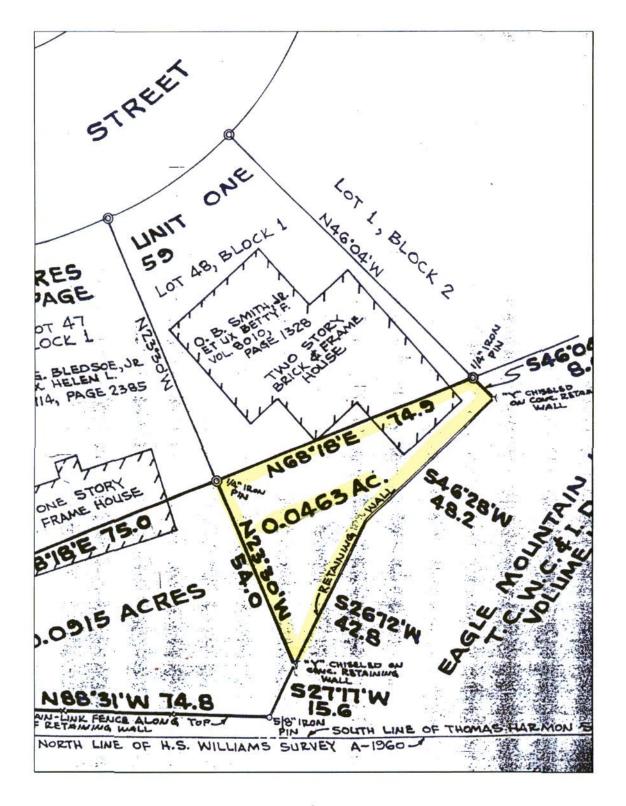
With the recommendation of management, Director Stevens moved to approve a contract with SI Precast to construct a segmented retaining wall on both sides of the river channel below the existing Southwest Blvd. Dam on the Clear Fork of the Trinity for the low bid of \$18.50 per face foot for approximately 11,500 face feet for a total not to exceed \$212,750. Funding for this contract is included in the FY 2006 General Fund Budget. Director Leonard seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

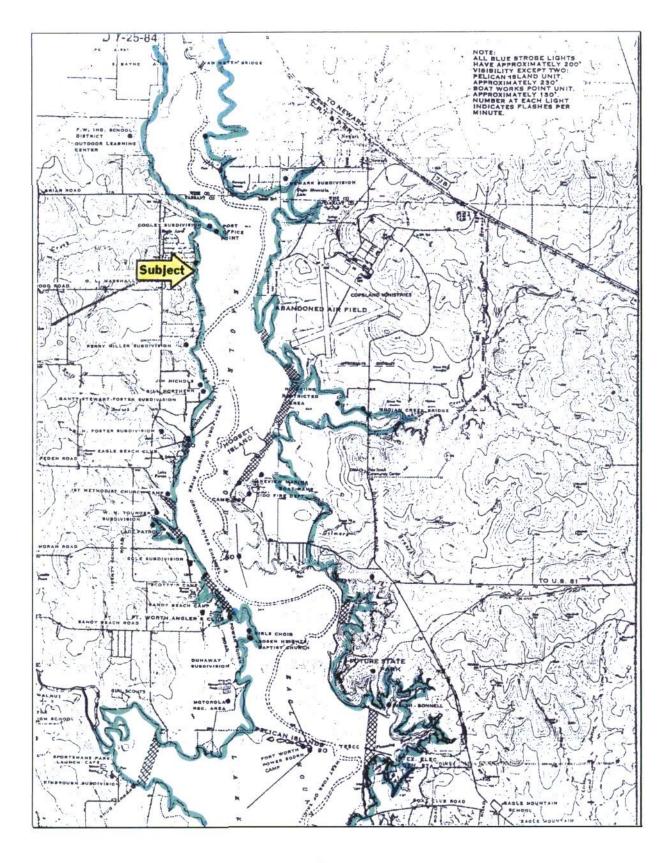

## Vicinity Map



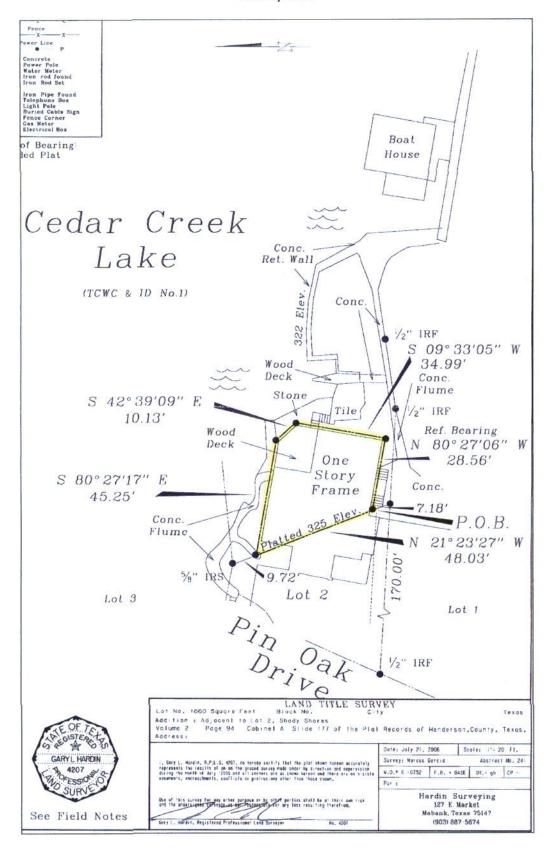
In addition, R. Steve Christian is granted authority to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction. Director Sparks seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

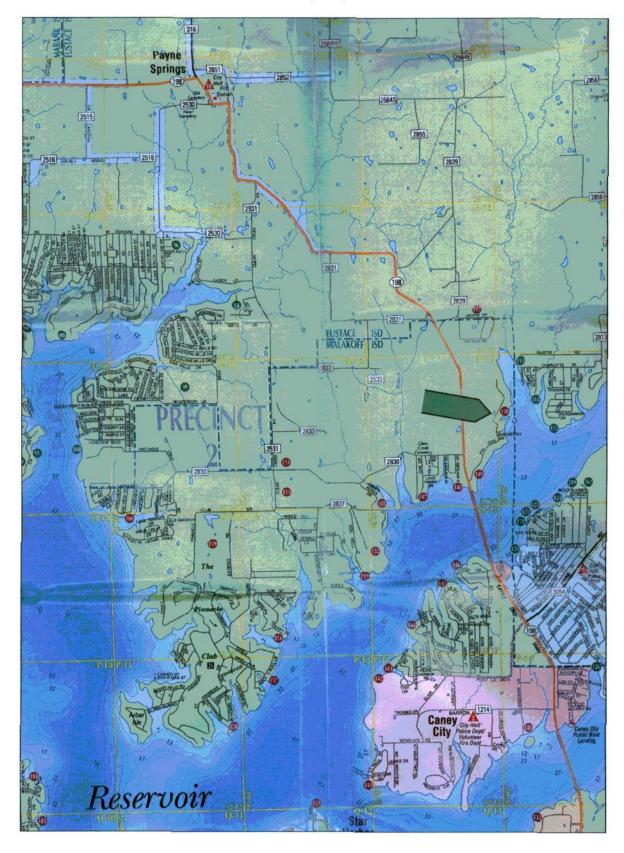

## Vicinity Map



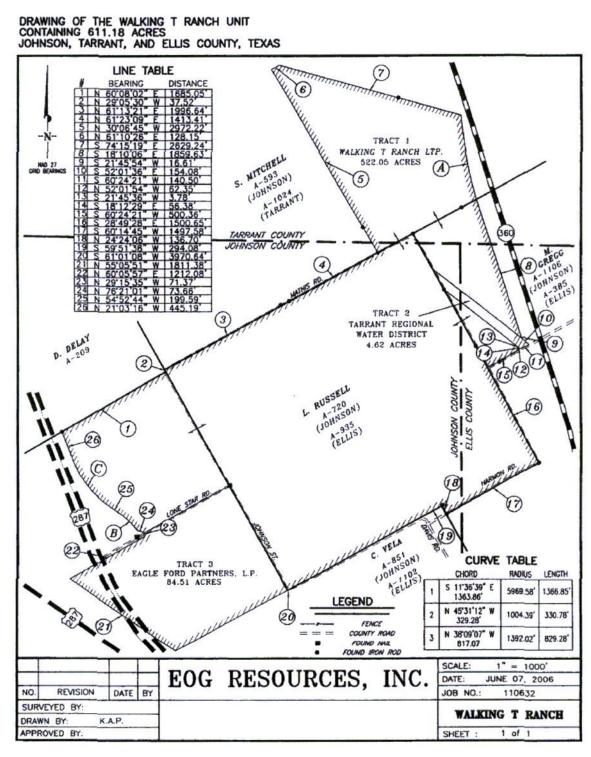
In addition, R. Steve Christian is granted authority to execute all documents necessary to complete this transaction. Director Stevens seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

9.

With the recommendation of management and legal counsel, Director Lane, in compliance with provisions of the Federal Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, moved to adopt written policies and procedures governing property acquisition and relocation activities in connection with the Trinity River Vision Project. Director Sparks seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

10.

With the recommendation of management, Director Sparks moved to approve an oil and gas lease under private sale conditions to EOG Resources, Inc., with a pooling agreement which will assure the Water District a 4.62/611.18 acre tract participation in the Walking T Unit without allowing any drilling operations on this 4.62 acres of land in the M. Gregg Survey, A-385 Ellis County, Texas as shown on plat marked Exhibit A, for a bonus amount of \$6,930 with a 25% royalty, three (3) year primary term.



In addition, Ken Brummett is granted authority to execute the lease and all other documents necessary to complete this transaction. Director Leonard seconded the motion and the vote in favor was unanimous.

The Board was updated on the progress of Eagle Mountain Park Land and the Water Supply System Status.
