Districts: "The Directors of each District shall have and maintain a regular office suitable for conducting the affairs of such District, within a town situated within the general boundary lines of such district and not removed therefrom, and such Directors shall hold regular meetings at said office on the first monday in February, May, August and November of each year, at 10 o'clock A. M., and any such tax payer or interested party may attend any such meeting of such Directors but shall not participate in any such meeting without the consent of the directors——but may present such matters as they desire to such

Directors in an orderly manner." and.

there appearing no interested party or parties, at said meeting and the dispetates the Directors feeling that the Law had been complied with in this respect, President Turner declared the meeting open for any other business necessary at this time, whereupon, the minutes of last meeting was read by Secretary W. E. Bideker, after which they were approved.
