AT A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE, HELD IN THE CITY OF FORT WORTH ON JULY 5th, 1927.

Present; A. L. Baker, President, H. M. Hightower, L. C. Abbott, W. H. Slay and W. E. Bideker, directors, constituting the entire membership of the Board. A. L. Baker, President of the Board presided; the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

The President stated that the Board on June 1st, 1926, had eliminated from the District certain lands, and defined the boundaries of the lands remaining in the District, as now appears of record in the minutes of the District and in the public records of Tarrant County, Texas. That on May 14th, 1927, the Directors did by order entered that day in the minutes and records of the District, eliminate certain lands from the District. That said order of elimination was published and served by mail as required by law, the first publication and service being on May 18th, 1927, and the second on May 25th, 1927. That more than thirty days have elapsed since the first publication of that notice, and no protest thereto has been filed with the board, whereby said order has become effective. That a motion to file the order of exclusion in the office of the County Clerk of Tarrant County, Texas, and as well to pass an order defining the boundaries of the District as the same is now constituted would be in order.

Thereupon Director W. E. Bideker moved the adoption of a resolution in words and figures as follows: viz:

Clerk of Tarrant County, Texas, Tarrant being the County in which all the lands defined of the District are located."

Director Hightower made the motion for adoption of the foregoing resolution. Upon a vote the resolution was unanimously adopted. The President thereupon declared the Board adjourned subject to call.
