At this meeting Director W. R. Bennett presided in his capacity as President; Director W. K. Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

At this meeting the following proceedings were had and taken, viz:

- 1. The minutes of the meeting of December 19th, 1928, were read, approved and ordered of record.
- 2. After full discussion of the change in the personel of the Tax Collector for the District, the Board did request the committee on Organization and Administration promptly to have made a detailed audit of the accounts of John Pengilly as Tax Collector of the District, in order that the District might at the earliest possible time make a settlement of this matter and come to an accord before the surrender of the bond of John Pengilly, as Tax Collector. It was also the sense of the Board that Mr. Cooke, as Chairman of the Committee on Organization and Administration, should, with the aid of the Attorneys, prepare a contract with Pat Card for service as Tax Collector for the District and after making of this contract procure a bond to cover the acts of Pat Card, as Tax Collector for the District.
- 3. Thereupon there was presented to the Directors an analysis of the liabilities and resources of the district which analysis is hereto attached as "Exhibit A" and made a part of these minutes. After an examination of the same by the Directors, it was ordered that Vouchers numbers 1455 to 1472, inclusive, to coverthe now mature and current obligations of the District to January 1st, 1929, totaling \$1,509.87, do be issued and delivered. Further, it was ordered that the District's voucher No. 1473, for the sum Eleven Hundred Sixty and No/100 (\$1160.00) Dollars, do be issued for the purpose of procuring funds to discharge the cost of holding the District election on January 8, 1929.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
