Further, that circulars giving such advice do be prepared and mailed by the District to all persons interested in said bonds where such interest has been heretofore made known to the District by written advice now contained in the District's files.

Further, that said notice shall contain advice that the bonds are being offered subject to approval, as to validity, by Chapman & Cutler of New York and Chicago, or Clay, Dillon & Vandewater of New York, at the option of the successful bidder for the bonds, the opinion as to validity to be paid for by the District.

Further, that all costs and expenses necessary to effect the purposes of this motion do be hereby authorized and that upon presentation and proper evidence of indebtedness the District's voucher do be issued in payment for all such necessary expenses. This motion was seconded by Director Stripling. Upon a vote being taken all the Directors present voted for the motion and no director voted against the motion: The motion was carried and it is so ordered.

2. There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
