MINUTES OF A REGULAR WEEKLY MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE ON DECEMBER 17, 1929, AT 3 O'CLOCK P.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence or absence of the directors as follows, viz:

Director E. E. Bewley, Vice President, presided; Director W. K. Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

The following proceedings were had and done, viz:

- 1. The minutes of the Meeting of December 10, 1929, were read, approved and ordered of record.
- The reupon, Director Bewley, as Custodian of the Securities pledged by the District's Depository, did present a signed reciprocal receipt, executed by the Texas National Bank, the District's Depository, and by Mr. Bewley, as Custodian of Securities. Under this Reciprocal Receipt it was proposed to withdraw from pledge certain Securities aggregating \$20,000.00. It was proposed to substitute therefor certain other securities aggregating \$20,000.00. Director Bewley stated that in his opinion the request for substitution should be granted and that the security of the District would be preserved in case of such substitution. An identical list of the Securities so proposed to be withdrawn from pledge and those proposed to be substituted in pledge is attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit A", and is made a part hereof. Upon consideration of the proposal by the Directors, it was moved by Director Stripling that the withdrawal of securities and substitution of securities, as proposed, do be authorized: that Director Bewley, as Custodian of Securities do be authorized to effect this substitution: further, that an identical Reciprocal Receipt do be attached to the bond of the Depository as "Exhibit 11". This motion was seconded by Director Hogsett. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it is so ordered.
- 3. Vouchers of the District proposed to be issued by the District were presented, approved and ordered issued as follows:

4. The reupon Mr. Sam J. Calloway and Damon Davis, representing the Commissioners' Court of Tarrant County, Texas, asked for conference with the Directors. There also came Mr. Peden, and seven others, who are land owners in the area affected by the Eagle Mountain Reservoir. They presented a petition, signed by themselves and many others, which related to their requrest that the District provide a bridge crossing the Eagle Mountain Lake, at a point known as the Dido Crossing. Mr. Davis and Mr. Calloway supported the request of this delegation and presented a map showing how construction of this Lake would affect old roads and also showing proposed new roads which they deemed to be required to be constructed in order reasonably to care for travel in the northwestern part of Tarrant County. After full hearing and discussion, it was the sense of the Directors that the Engineer for the County and the Engineers for the

District make a mature investigation of all factors involved and report back to the. Directors of the District at such time as it might be presented full data concerning not only proposals, but as well to include the value of present roads to be submerged and the cost of such roads as are proposed to be provided.

- 5. The reupon the Land Committee made a report of their tentative contracts to purchase lands and, or, to lease lands as follows, viz:
- (a) Contract to purchase land from Dr. K. L. Buckner, in fee: 14.47 acres for the gross sum \$542.62; Also, purchase of the right to take materials from 38.15 acres of land, in consideration of the advance payment of \$381.50. Said contract for purchase and rights is here referred to for more particular knowledge of the expressed terms.
- (b) Contract to purchase from R. L. Morris: 4 acres in easement for the gross sum \$12.00.
- (c) Contract to purchase from W. C. Huddleston, in fee: 41.82 acres of land @ \$60.00 per acre; further, carrying an agreement that the land be leased to Mr. Huddleston for the year 1930, for the sum of \$1.00 per acre, payable in advance.
- (d) To purchase from A. Gant, approximately 200 acres in fee at \$55.00 per acre; and to purchase an easement on approximately 50 acres @ \$3.00 per acre.
- (e) To purchase from W. M. Dunaway: 4.32 acres of land @ \$50.00 per acre.
  - (f) To purchase from Mrs. Sprinkle and Mrs. Trimble, approximately 2 acres the price of \$48.00 per acre. It was explained that this land was not well defined, but that it was a part of the land formerly owned by W. N. Younger.
- (g) To purchase from the Estate of N. E. Hopper: 386.5 acres of land, more or less, at \$30.00 per acre.

The Land Committee made recommendation that each and all of these purchases do be approved and authorized. After consideration of each proposal it was moved by Director Hogsett that the purchases and contracts as proposed do be approved, confirmed and ordered consummated. Further, as to the Buckner contract, that either Director Stripling or Director Hickman do be authorized to formally execute the tendered contract as between this District and Dr. K. L. Buckner, and that such contract, when so executed, do be the act and deed of this District. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it is so ordered.

- (h) Thereupon there was presented to the Board a letter of Mr. Duke, concerning controversy with Mr. Grubbs, concerning his right to remove improvements from the land purchased from him. Upon full consideration of this, Director Stripling made a motion that the request be denied. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. The motion was carried and it is so ordered.
  - 6. No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
