At this meeting the call of the roll disclosed the presence of all the Directors as follows, viz:

Director Bennett presided in his capacity as President; Director Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

Thereupon the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

l. President Bennett laid before the Board the official returns of the election for directors held on Tuesday, January 14, A. D. 1930, to determine who should be chosen to serve as Directors of the District for the period of two years to succeed the expired terms of Directors W. R. Bennett, E. E. Bewley and W. K. Stripling. Thereupon, the Directors, as a committee of the whole, did proceed to canvas the returns of said election by precincts and did cast up the total votes cast for each of said named candidates. From the tabulation made the Directors find and do now here officially declare that the following named candidates received total votes each as follows, viz:

Further, it appears that all of the procedures incident to the ordering and holding of said election, and the manner of making returns thereon, did in all things comply with the law applicable thereto: By reason thereof it appears, and it hereby is declared, that W. R. Bennett, E. E. Bewley and W. K. Stripling have each received a lawful majority of the votes cast at said election and that Tom Murray failed as to election; by reason whereof, they, and each of them, have been duly elected as Directors of this District, to respectively serve from the time of their qualification to the second Tuesday in January A. D. 1932, or until the successor of any such Director may have been duly elected and qualified.

2. Thereupon Director Hogsett did make a motion that W. R. Bennett, E. E. Bewley and W. K. Stripling do be declared to have been elected as Directors of the District and that they do hereby be declared to be Directors of this District for two years from January 14, 1930, or until their successors shall have been duly elected and qualified in accordance with the law. Further, that the said W. R. Bennett, E. E. Bewley and W. K. Stripling, do take the oath of office prescribed by law, and present their good and sufficient bonds of office for approval by this Board. Further that upon the approval of their said bonds and oaths of office they shall be instantly constituted and established as Directors of this District for the terms hereinabove stated. Further, that there do be attached to these minutes as "Exhibit A" the tabulation of votes cast in said election showing the number of votes cast for each candidate in each of the precincts of this District. Further, that said "Exhibit A" do be identified by the signatures of

of the President and Secretary of the District. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it is so ordered.

- 3. Thereupon there were presented to the Directors the respective official bonds and oaths of office of W. R. Bennett, E. E. Berley and W. K. Stripling, they being the Directors hereinbefore declared to have been elected as Directors of this District: Said bonds and oaths of office were examined by the Directors and counsel for the District, and each, upon the advice of counsel, was determined to be in conformity to the law, and each of said bonds was determined to be a good and sufficient bond. Thereupon Director Hickman made a motion that the Directors of the District, as the act and deed of the District, do approve said bonds and oaths of office bf the said W. R. Bennett, E. Berley and W. K. Stripling; That the original bonds and oaths of office be filed, recorded and deposited as required by law, and that a true copy of the original of each be, in folio, attached to these minutes as "Exhibit B", which shall be part of these minutes. The motion was seconded by Director Hogsett: Upon a vote being taken, all Directors voted for the motion and no director voted against the motion: The motion was carried and said W. R. Bennett, E. B. Beley and W. K. Stripling are hereby established to be duly elected and qualified as Directors of this District.
- 4. There being no further business offered, the meeting was adjourned.
