MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE, HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, ON MARCH 12, 1930 AT 3 P. M.

This meeting was called in the place and stead of the omitted regular weekly meeting of Tuesday, March 11, 1930. There were present at this time and place Directors as follows, viz: W. R. Bennett, who presided in his capacity as President, E. E. Bewley, Joe B. Hogsett, C. A. Hickman and W. K. Stripling, who acted in his capacity as Secretary.

Thereupon the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

1. There were read for consideration and approval Minutes of meetings of the Board of Directors of this District as follows, viz:

(a) February 25, 1930 at 3 o'clock P. M.,
(b) March 4, 1930 at 3 o'clock P. M.,
(c) March 7, 1930 at 10 o'clock A. M.,
(d) March 7, 1930 at 11 o'clock A. M.,
(e) March 11, 1930 at 12 noon.

After reading and consideration of the Minutes of each of said meetings, it was the sense of the Directors that the same and all of the same do be approved, and it is so ordered:

2. Thereupon there were presented to the Directors a list of all voucher checks authorized and issued by the Directors since February 21, 1930, and covering serial numbers from 1930 to 1946, both inclusive, together with statement of the condition of the funds of the District as of March 12, 1930. The same were examined and approved by the Directors and they are attached to the Minutes of this meeting as "Exhibit A" and made part hereof.

3. Thereupon there were presented to the Directors for approval and execution voucher checks of the District to cover sums now payable by the District, which voucher checks were from \$1947 and consecutively to include \$1983, for the aggregate sum \$3,085.60. The itemized data concerning said checks is attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit B" and is made part hereof. Each of the accounts on which the proposed payments were based was examined by the Directors. Each was found to be due and payable. Whereupon Director Bewley made a motion that the accounts as presented do be approved and allowed; that the voucher checks as presented for execution do be executed and that they be delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive the same. This motion was seconded by Director Stripling; upon vote being taken the motion was carried and it is so ordered:

4. Thereupon there were presented to the Directors for examination and approval voucher checks which were necessary to be issued in order to anticipate the maturity of certain specific accounts and having serial numbers, dates and amounts as follows, viz:

> (a) No. 1984, dated March 14, 1930, payable to the Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, Texas, in order to transfer by telegraph money to Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company of New York, to protect interest coupons of this District payable on March 15, 1930 -\$83,340.00

- (b) No. 1985, dated March 14, 1930, payable to the Continental National
   Bank, in order to affect transfer by telegraph of \$83.34 to the Central Hanover Bank and Trust Company of New York, in payment of their handling charge on the interest coupons of the District - \$83.34

Each and all of the anticipated accounts were examined by the Directors and each and all of the same were approved. The stated engineer's estimate No. 1, concerning the progress of the work was examined by the Directors: It was stated by Mr. Ed B. Cheatham, as Accountant for the District, that the extensions had been verified by him and that the same were correct. Said estimate number one is attached to the Minutes of this meeting as "Exhibit C" and is made part hereof. Thereupon Director E. E. Bewley made a motion that the several voucher checks as proposed do be approved; that they do be executed and that they do be delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive the same as when, but not until, Continental National Bank shall have been fully qualified as the District Designated Substitute Depository. Further, that the engineer's estimate No. 1, concerning the progress of the work, do be approved and allowed. This motion was seconded by Director Hogsett; upon vote being taken, all of the Directors voted for the motion and no Director voted against the motion. The motion was carried and it is so ordered.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
