W. R. Bennett presided in his capacity as President; C. A. Hickman acted as Secretary.

Minutes of the Meeting of July 27, 1931, were read, approved and ordered of record.

2.

The report of the District's Auditors, for the month of July, 1931, was fully considered and ordered received and filed of record, as "Exhibit A" to the Minutes of this meeting.

3.

Director Bewley made a motion that the Auditors for the District be requested to carry into their monthly reports all exceptions, unsettled items, and other matters referred to Committees for action and report. This motion was seconded by Director Hogsett. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

4.

There were presented for approval and execution District Voucher Checks, as follows, viz:

- (a) No. 2564 Payable to W. A. Taylor and I. J. Taylor, as consideration for 25.32 acres of land, to be placed under easement to the District @ \$5.00 per acre, for the sum \$126.60;
- (b) No. 2565 Payable to G. W. Trussell and Loyrene Trussell, being consideration for 1.58 acres of land placed

under an easement to the District @ \$5.00 per acre \$ 7.90.

Each of said checks was accompanied by a certificate of the Engineers, certifying the necessity of the District to have said easements. There was no certificate by the Attorneys concerning the title, due to the fact that this requirement had been waived by the Board of Directors, as appears from the Minutes of July 13, 1931. There was full consideration of these matters, whereupon Director Bewley made a motion, which was seconded by Director Hogsett, that said two voucher checks, as listed, do be approved, issued and delivered to the parties entitled to receive the same, upon condition, however, that the District concurrently be invested with title to said easements in the usual form. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

#### REPORT OF LAND COMMITTEE

Director Hickman presented proposed contract signed by A.

B. VanNeter, dated August 1, 1931, wherein he, as Administrator of the Estate of

C. J. VanNeter, deceased, proposed to sell to the District in fee 50 acres of

land at the rate of \$40.00 per acre. There was full consideration of this matter

whereupon Director Hogsett made a motion that said proposed purchase do be approved,

and consummated in the usual manner. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman.

Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.
