MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE ON AUGUST 11, 1931, AT 3 P. M. (said meeting having been recessed from August 10, 1931, because of no quorum)

The call of the roll disclosed the presence, or absence, of Directors as follows:

PRESENT: W. R. Bennett E. E. Bewley C. A. Hickman ABSENT: W. K. Stripling (Out of City. Joe B. Hogsett)

At this meeting the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

W. R. Bennett presided in his capacity as President; C. A. Hickman, in the absence of Director Stripling, acted as Secretary.

1.

Minutes of the Meeting of August 3, 1931, were read approved and ordered of record.

2.

The report of the finances of this District, as of August 10, 1931, is attached to these Minutes, and hereby is made part hereof, as "Exhibit A." Said report shows voucher checks issued since the meeting of July 7, 1931, Numbers 2559 to 2565, both inclusive, for the sum \$11,1/4,50. Also, proposed voucher checks Numbers 2566 to 2589, both inclusive, for the total sum \$168,641.&, which are checks proposed to be issued to cover sums now due and payable by the District. There was full consideration of these voucher checks and the data to support the same, whereupon Director Bewley made a motion that voucher checks Numbers 2567 to 2587, both inclusive, for the total sum \$1947.69, do be approved, issued and delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive the same. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered. Attached to these Minutes, in folio, and as "Exhibit B," is the Engineers' Estimate No. 18, of the Progress of the Work, to cover the period from July 5, 1931, to August 5, 1931. This estimate discloses sums to be payable to the Contractor as of August 5, 1931, as follows:

On the Eagle Mountain Dam Work	\$80,988.83;
On the Bridgeport Dam Work	74,616.21;
Making total sum of	\$155,605.04

There was full examination of this Estimate, together with the data to support the same, whereupon Director Bewley made a motion that said Estimate do be approved and that the District's voucher check No. 2566, payable to the Contractors for the sum \$155,605.04, do be approved, issued and delivered to the Contractors as a payment on account and as an advance of working capital. Further, that said sum be paid, subject to the reservation heretofore made concerning exception to the item of extra work heretofore called into question, and relating to the construction of a concrete cut-off wall at the Berkshire Levee. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

4.

The Engineers' Final Estimate, for the clearing of the land purchased by the District from Will Laird and Mrs. M. M. Laird, is attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit C," and hereby is made part hereof. There was full consideration of this matter, whereupon Director Hickman moved that said Estimate do be approved and allowed, and that the District's voucher check No. 2588, payable to Frank Turner and others, for the sum \$5089.09, do be executed and delivered to the payees, in full satisfaction of the labor performed under the contract with the payees and this District. Further, that the Contractors bond, heretofore given,

executed and delivered by Frank Turner, W. A. Brown and W. A. Whitton, dated the 19th day of June, 1931, and signed by The Employers' Liability Assurance Corporation, Ltd., as Surety, do be authorized for release and cancellation. This motion was seconded by Director Bewley. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

5.

Attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit D," is the Engineers' Estimate No. 23, concerning their claim as to the amount due and payable by the District to them, under their contract with this District. The stated claim was for the sum \$18,569.07, and the request was for the payment of \$6,000.00 on account. Upon consideration of this matter, Director Hickman made a motion that the District's voucher check No. 2589, payable to Hawley and Freese, for the sum \$6,000.00 do be approved, issued and delivered to the payees, as a payment on account. This motion was seconded by Director Bewley. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

6.

Thereupon there came on for discussion the question as to whether the District should request Mr. W. E. Yancy, County Auditor of Tarrant County, Texas, to make an audit for this District concerning the collection of taxes by the Tax Collector for this District, for the year next succeeding the period covered by the prior audit made by Mr. Yancy, as the same appears in the records of this District, as "Exhibit A," to the Minutes of June 15, 1931. It was explained that the cost of the service would be upon the same basis as that for the said prior audit. Upon consideration of this matter Director Bewley made a motion that the District do request Mr. Yancy to render the stated service, and to be compensated on the same basis as was provided for said prior audit. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

7.

There was presented to the Directors a proposal to purchase from R. L. Morris certain land and easement upon land, in the Bridgeport basin, deeded by C. W. Stephens and wife, to R. L. Morris, for conveyance by him to this District, as appears from the deed of date, August 3, 1931, for the total consideration \$291.25, said land and easement being as follows:

> To be conveyed in fee, 11.65 acres; and 1.34 acres in Easement, for the total consideration of \$291.25.

This proposal was accompanied by the certificate of the District Engineers as to the necessity of the District to acquire said land; and was accompanied by the certificate of the Attorneys for the District as to the validity of the title to said land.

Upon consideration of this matter, Director Hickman moved that said proposal to purchase do be approved and consummated in the usual manner; further, that the District's voucher check No. 2590, payable to R. L. Morris, for the sum \$291.25, do be executed and delivered to R. L. Morris, at such time as he may actually deliver to the District good and valid deed. This motion was seconded by Director Bewley. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
