MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE ON DECEMBER 15, 1931, 4:30 PM.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence of all directors as follows, viz:

W. K. Stripling
C. A. Hickman
Joe B. Hogsett

Director Bennett presided in his capacity as President; Director Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

At this time and place the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

1.

There was presented to the Directors for consideration a letter written to Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, Texas, on December 14, and signed by W. V. Cunningham, County Clerk of Wise County, Texas, whereby he consented that the Continental National Bank clip from 35 United States Government Bonds, held by the Continental National Bank in pledge to secure the deposit in the J. T. Counts Condemnation Proceeding, the coupons maturing December 15, 1931. There was full consideration of this matter, whereupon Director Bewley moved the adoption of a resolution to the effect that the District was not in a position to object to the release of the coupons and that the District should ratify and approve the written consent executed by Mr. Cunningham: Further, that he (Director Bewley, as Custodian, and Chairman of the Finance Committee). do be authorized to make written consent. The adoption of this resolution was seconded by Director Stripling. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered. A copy of said order, together with the copy of the letter written by the First National Bank of Bridgeport, Texas, are, in folio, attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit A."

There was presented to the Directors for consideration request of the Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, as District Depository, dated December 14, 1931, requesting that it be permitted to withdraw from pledge fifty (50) bonds of this District, of par value \$50,000.00. With said request there was presented a proposed reciprocal receipt, executed by the Bank and to be executed by this District, when approved. The bonds to be withdrawn are specifically described in said proposed receipt. There was full consideration of this matter, whereupon Director Bewley made a motion that said request do be granted: that he do be permitted to make delivery of the bonds described in said proposed receipt; further, that when the delivery had been accomplished and the said reciprocal receipt fully executed, that said request for the withdrawal and one of the said receipts do be attached to these Minutes. in folio. as "Exhibit B;" further, that one of said executed receipts do be attached to the depository bond of this District as "Exhibit 30," as is provided for by said bond. This motion was seconded by Director Hogsett. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

3.

Director Bewley presented to the Board for consideration the oral request of the Continental National Bank that it immediately after actual payment of the District Check No. 2699, to the Contractors for completion of the Bridgeport Works, for the sum \$242,940.36, do be permitted to withdraw from pledge bonds of the United States of America of the par value \$140,000.00, and bonds of Fort Worth Independent School District, of the par value \$100,000.00, making total \$240,000.00. With said request was presented a proposed reciprocal

receipt specifically describing the bonds which the Bank desired to withdraw from pledge. There was full consideration of this matter, whereupon Director Fogsett made a motion that when said check for said sum \$242,940.36 had been actually paid by the Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, that Director Bewley, as Custodian of Pledges, do be authorized, without further order from this Board, to deliver to said Bank the bonds in said proposed receipt described; further, that upon actual delivery of said bonds said proposed receipt do be executed by the Bank, and by Director Bewley, in the name of this District; further, that one of said receipts, when executed, do be attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit C," and that one of such multiple reciprocal receipts do be attached to the official bond of the District Depository Bank as "Exhibit 31." This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken, the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
