MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1933, 4:30 P. M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence of, or absence of, Directors as follows:

President Bennett presided; Director Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

At this time and place the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

1.

Minutes of called meetings of January 10, 1933, February 6, 1933, February 13, 1933 @ 7:30 P. M. and February 13, 1933 @ 8:30 P. M., and March 13, 1933, were read and approved and ordered of record.

2.

President Bennett stated that in telegrams of March 10 and 14, received from Mr. Ireland Hampton (who is in Washington, D. C., in the interest of a loan for this District with the Reconstruction Finance Corporation), he made request that a deposit of \$7,00.00 be placed in his account at the Continental National Bank of this City, and that after conferring with the several other directors, he had caused this District's voucher check #3134, payable to Ireland Hampton for \$700.00 (\$500.00 being for March, 1933, salary, and \$200.00 as an advance on expenses) to be issued and deposited as per Mr. Hampton's request, and asked that the Board ratify the issuance of this voucher check. Director Hickman made a motion that the issuance of voucher check #3134 for \$700.00 to Ireland Hampton do be ratified, the motion was seconded by Director Stripling. Upon a vote being taken, the motion carried and it was so ordered.

President Bennett then presented proposed voucher checks #3135, payable to the Continental National Bank, Fort Worth, Texas, for \$2.96, to cover the cost of telegram, in transferring funds to the Central Hanover Bank and Trust Co., New York, to pay maturing Bonds and Interest Coupons, etc., on March 15, 1933. Voucher Check #3136, payable to L. P. Card, Tax Collector, Tarrant County, Texas, for \$375.00, being payment in full for services rendered as Tax Collector for this District in accordance with the terms of signed contract dated September 16, 1932. Director Stripling made a motion that the proposed voucher checks do be executed and delivered to the respective parties entitled to receive same. Director Hickman seconded the motion. Upon a vote being taken the motion carried and it was so ordered.

4.

Director Bewley presented two multiple reciprocal receipts dated
February 15 and March 14, 1933, of the Continental National Bank, Fort Worth,
Texas, the District's Depository, acknowledging receipt of the withdrawal from
pledge, certain securities as described in said receipts. He stated that before
making delivery of the securities, he had conferred with the several other Directors and did now make request that the Directors approve, ratify and confirm
the delivery of said securities, whereupon Director Hickman made a motion that
the Directors approve, ratify and confirm the delivery of said securities; further, that one of each receipts do be attached to these minutes as
"Exhibit A" and one of each receipts do be attached to the bond of the District's
Official Depository as "Exhibits #46 and #47, as provided for by the terms of said
bond. This motion was seconded by Director Bewley. Upon a vote being taken the
motion carried and it was so ordered.

Director Hickman as Chairman of the Land Committee, presented a proposal from G. A. Culver to lease for the balance of the year 1933, approximately 30 acres of land which the District had purchased from J. B. Hoskins, Tract #344A, the proposed consideration to be \$30.00 of which amount \$25.00 cash accompanied the proposal, leaving a balance of \$5.00 to be paid. Director Hickman made a motion that the proposal be accepted subject to the balance due by Mr. Culver, do be paid before consummation of the lease and that Mr. Culver does actually enter into formal written contract for lease, to be conditioned as required by the District. This motion was seconded by Director Bewley. Upon a vote being taken, the motion carried and it was so ordered.

No further business was presented and the meeting adjourned.
