MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 22ND DAY OF JUNE, 1933, 4 P. M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence, or absence, of Directors as follows:

President Bennett presided; W. K. Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

At this time and place the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

1.

Minutes of a meeting of June 20, 1933, were read, approved and ordered of record.

2.

It was called to the attention of the Directors that the District now held the good faith check of the Continental National Bank for the sum \$1500.00, which was delivered enclosed with the bid of said Bank to become the depositary for this District, on June 5, 1933. Said Cashier's Check No. 05082 of Continental National Bank, dated June 5, 1933, payable to the order of this District, was presented. It appeared that the Continental National Bank since the delivery of said check had actually qualified as depositary for the District, whereupon Director Bewley made a motion that said check be by the District delivered back to the Continental National Bank. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered. (Receipt govering return of said check is attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit 1.")

There was presented to the Directors for consideration the necessity to make provision for the cancellation of 463 bonds of the District of "Series D", which bonds are to be superceded by the 463 bonds of the District's "Series D 2". Director Bewley made a motion that said bonds to be cancelled do be transmitted by the Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, to the Comptroller of the State of Texas, by insured registered mail (as set out in "Exhibit A" hereto attached). Further, that the Bank do be authorized to pay for said insurance at the actual cost thereof and charge the same to this District. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

3.

Attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit B," is a letter directed to the Comptroller of the State of Texas (together with an amendment thereof), wherein said Comptroller in substance is durected: (a) To cancel and destroy the 463 bonds of Series D; to cancel and destroy the 45 notes of this District, payable to Reconstruction Finance Corporation; and (b) to actually register the 463 bonds of this District, which are to be issued in lieu of the 463 bonds of "Series D."

Upon consideration of said matter, Director Hickman made a motion that the proposed letters to the Comptroller do be executed by the appropriate officers of the District, and be delivered to Ireland Hampton, as Attorney for the District with instructions to him to proceed to Austin for the accomplishment of any and all things lawfullyto be required to accomplish the prior order of this District concerning said notes and bonds; further, that the cost of so doing be authorized as a proper expenditure for the District. This motion was

seconded by Director Stripling. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

4.

Attached to these Minutes, in folio, as "Exhibit C" are certain letters proposed to be executed by Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, and directed to Austin National Bank of Austin, Texas; Chapman & Cutler of Chicago, Ill.; Treasurer of Reconstruction Finance Corporation, Washington, D. C., and the Federal Reserve Bank of Dallas, all relating to the disposition of certain bonds of "Series D 2" of the District; also, a receipt proposed to be executed by the Austin National Bank for the bonds of Series D 2. Reference is here made to said folio as part hereof. Director Bewley made a motion that said letters of advice proposed to be written by Continental National Bank and the Receipt to be executed by the Austin National Bank do be approved for execution and that compliance with said letters of instruction do be authorized as the acts and deeds of the District. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
