MINUTES OF A CALLED MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TARRANT COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NUMBER ONE HELD IN THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN FORT WORTH, TEXAS, ON THE 10TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1934, 3:30 P.M.

The call of the roll disclosed the presence, or absence, of directors as follows:

PRESENT

ABSENT

W. K. Stripling C. A. Hickman Joe B. Hogsett W. R. Bennett E. E. Bewley

Due to the absence of President Bennett, and Vice-President Bewley, the Directors present chose Director Hogsett to preside as Chairman of this meeting. Director Stripling acted in his capacity as Secretary.

At this time and place the following proceedings were had and done, viz:

1.

Minutes of the meeting of August 7, 1934, were read, approved and ordered of record.

2.

Attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit A" is a statement of the Financial Condition of the District as of this day, which here is referred to as part hereof. This shows Voucher Check No. 3800, for the sum \$2,550.00, payable to Hawley & Freese, issued and delivered since the last meeting; also, proposed voucher checks consecutive and inclusive serial numbers 3801 to 3836, for the total
sum \$153,156.53. There was consideration of said proposed voucher checks, together with data to support the same, and it was found that the accounts covered

by said checks were now due and payable by the district, whereupon Director Stripling made a motion that the said accounts do be approved for payment; and that said voucher checks do be executed and delivered to the respective persons entitled to receive the same. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

3.

There were presented to the Directors reciprocal receipts as between the District and the Continental National Bank of Fort Worth, as the District Depositary, each being executed by an appropriate officer of said Bank and by Director Bewley, in his capacity as Custodian of Pledges, for the District, which receipts are as follows:

- (a) Exhibit No. 29, dated August 20, 1934, showing withdrawal of securities in the par sum \$10,000.00, and the substitution of securities in the par sum \$12,000.00.
- (b) Exhibit No. 30, dated August 22, 1934, showing the deposit of securities of the par sum \$12,000.00.
- (c) Exhibit No. 31, dated September 6, 1934, showing withdrawal of securities in the par sum \$12,000.00, and the substitution of securities in the sum \$15,000.00.

One of each of said exhibits, in folio, is attached to these Minutes as "Exhibit B", and reference is made thereto for a more particular description of said securities.

After consideration of the balances, of the district, on deposit in said Bank, and consideration of the value of the securities placed in pledge, the

directors were of the opinion that the prior action of Director Bewley in each of said matters do be, as recommended by him, approved and confirmed as the acts and deeds of the district as of the several dates named in said receipts; whereupon, Director Stripling made a motion that said transactions and the execution of said receipts, and the pledges evidenced thereby, do be ratified and approved as the acts and deeds of the district; further, that one of each of said reciprocal receipts do be attached to the bond of the depositary (to be respectively "Exhibits 29," "30," and "31" of said bond, as provided for in said bond). This motion was seconded by Director Hickman. Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

4.

There was presented to the Directors the report of the Engineers that a number of dairy cattle which were being pastured on the Carter-Meacham land at the East end of Eagle Mountain Dam, for lack of a fence, were able to go upon the down stream slope of the dam, for grazing the Bermuda grass; further, that they were doing considerable damage both to the grass and the embankment. It was recommended that the engineers be given authority to construct a fence adequate to prevent this injury. There was full consideration of this matter, and it was the sense of the directors that the Engineers be authorized to proceed for the purchase of materials and the construction of said fence, upon condition that no more money be spent than was absolutely required to exclude cattle from the district's dam. It was so ordered.

5.

There was presented to the Directors the report of the District

Auditors, dated August 16, 1934, covering the month of July and the year to date. Each of the directors had at a prior time received a copy of said report and was familiar with the contents thereof. It was the sense of the directors that the report required no action at this time and the same should be received and filed: It was so ordered.

6.

Director Stripling made a motion that the Finance Committee be requested and authorized to clip from the 126 unsold bonds held in the district's Treasury, the interest coupons attached thereto, which mature on September 15, 1934, to mutilate the same and to present them to the Directors at their next meeting, for cancellation. This motion was seconded by Director Hickman.

Upon a vote being taken the motion was carried and it was so ordered.

7.

It was the sense of the Directors that it should be noted in the record of the District that Messrs. Burch & Woodruff had no accrual for specific services or expenses incurred during the month of August, 1934. It was so ordered.

8.

No further business was presented and the meeting was adjourned.
