Construction Materials Testing and Special inspections

The Tarrant Regional Water District (TRWD) is hereby inviting Statements of Qualification (SOQ) from qualified consultants with construction materials testing and special inspections expertise interested in providing technical support services on an indefinite delivery and quantity (IDIQ) basis. There will be a rotation list assigned for a maximum of three (3) firms for each category. In order to be considered for a category listed below, Respondent **MUST** be able to perform all Subcategories within the Prime Category. Respondent must notate which categories they are submitting for.

The following are the types of services required for this solicitation:

Category A – Soils Compaction, Concrete and HMAC Testing

1. Soils-compaction/density testing
2. Lab testing – sampling, gradations, lime content, etc.
3. Concrete, Grout and Flowable Fill – strength, slump, air, batch plant
1. Asphalt and flex base – compaction/density testing, plant

Category B – NDT, Surface Preparation and Coatings Inspection

1. Factory certified welding inspection
2. Factory castings inspection – VT, UT, RT
3. NDE Evaluation specialists

Category C – Field Certified Welding Inspection

1. Field pipe joints certified welding inspection
