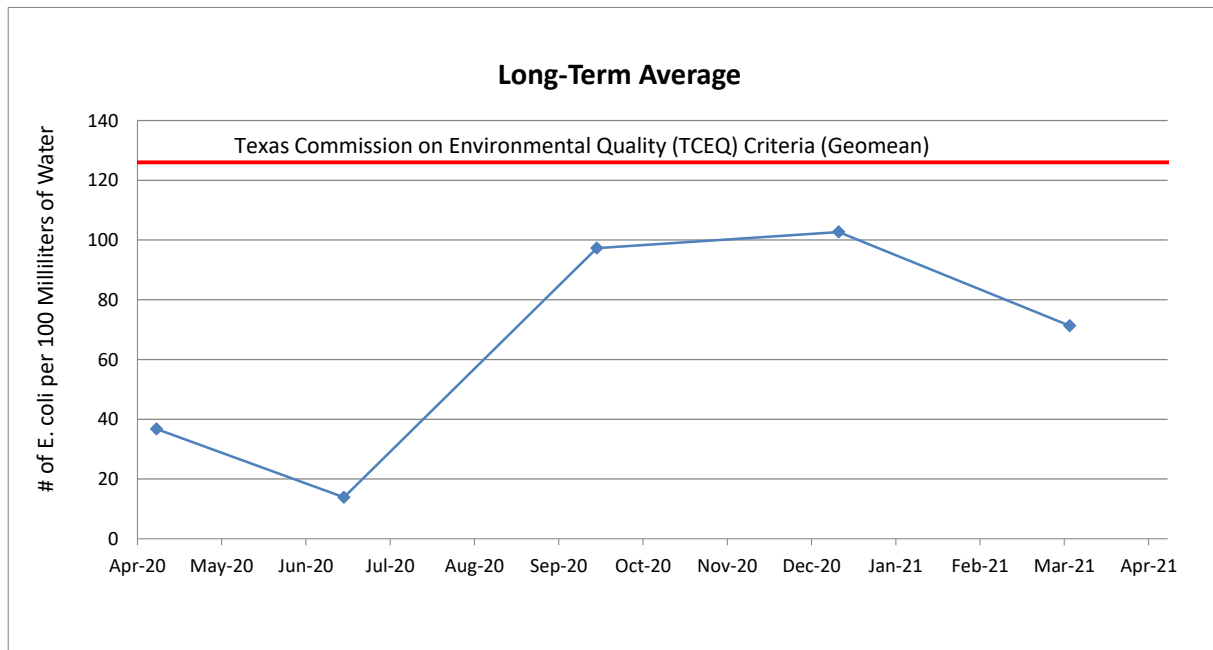
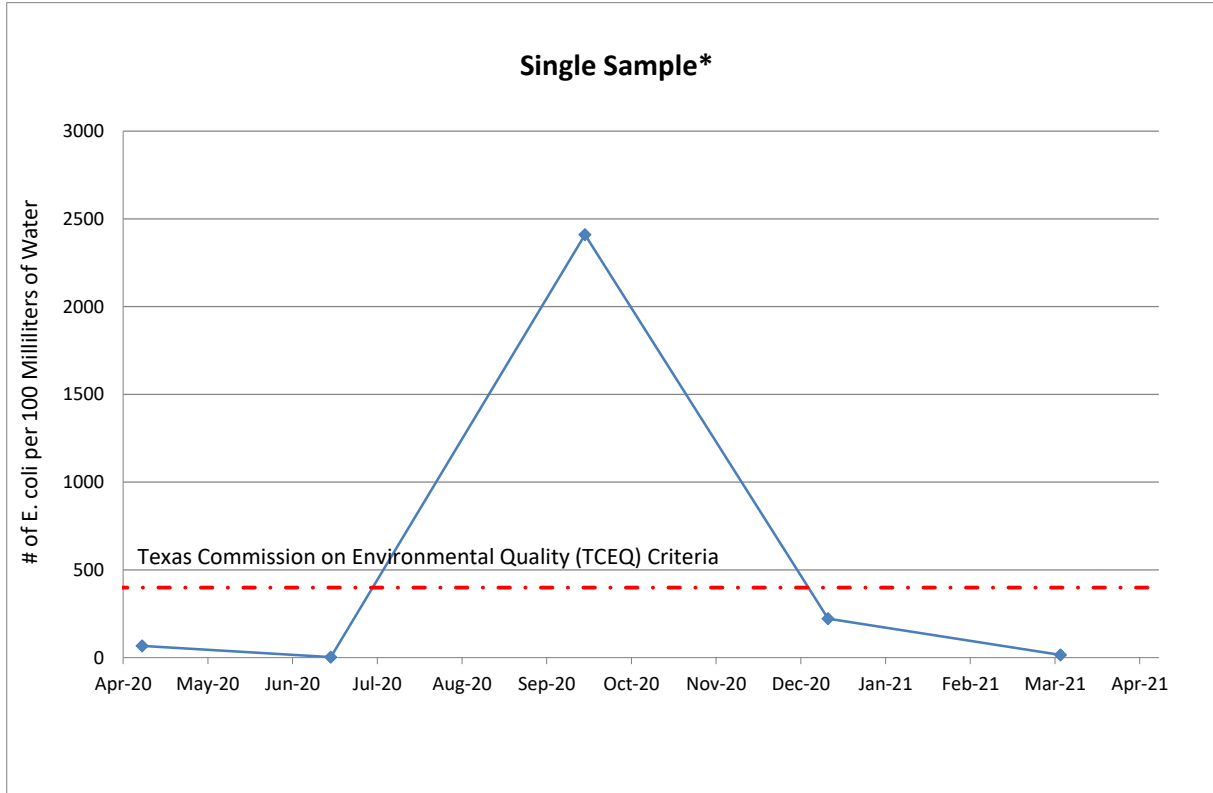


West Fork Trinity @ Beach Street Dam

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality considers a body of water acceptable for swimming, tubing, or boating when the long-term average bacteria concentration is below 126 bacteria per 100 milliliters of water and when a single sample is below 399 bacteria per 100 milliliters of water.
