- Compliance and cooperation with District staff and Legal Counsel; The individual/firm
 must be certified to provide real estate appraisal services in the State of Texas and have
 a minimum of five years of experience in providing such services to municipalities, water
 districts or government agencies.
- The individual/firm must also be experienced in expert opinions and testimony. If requested, the individual/firm must agree after completion of the requested Appraisal to consult with the Water District and its Legal Counsel and to furnish testimony as to the value of the Property and your work in preparing your Appraisal.
- All appraisals will be performed in accordance with Appendix A Appraisal Instructions and Agreement.

Statement of Qualifications for the above referenced project will be accepted by the Tarrant Regional Water District, Purchasing Department, electronically via the CivCast Procurement Website no later than 2:00 P.M. CST, November 30, 2022.

Submittals must be in the actual possession of Tarrant Regional Water District prior to the exact time and date indicated in this Request. Any submittal received after the foresaid time, will not be accepted.
