

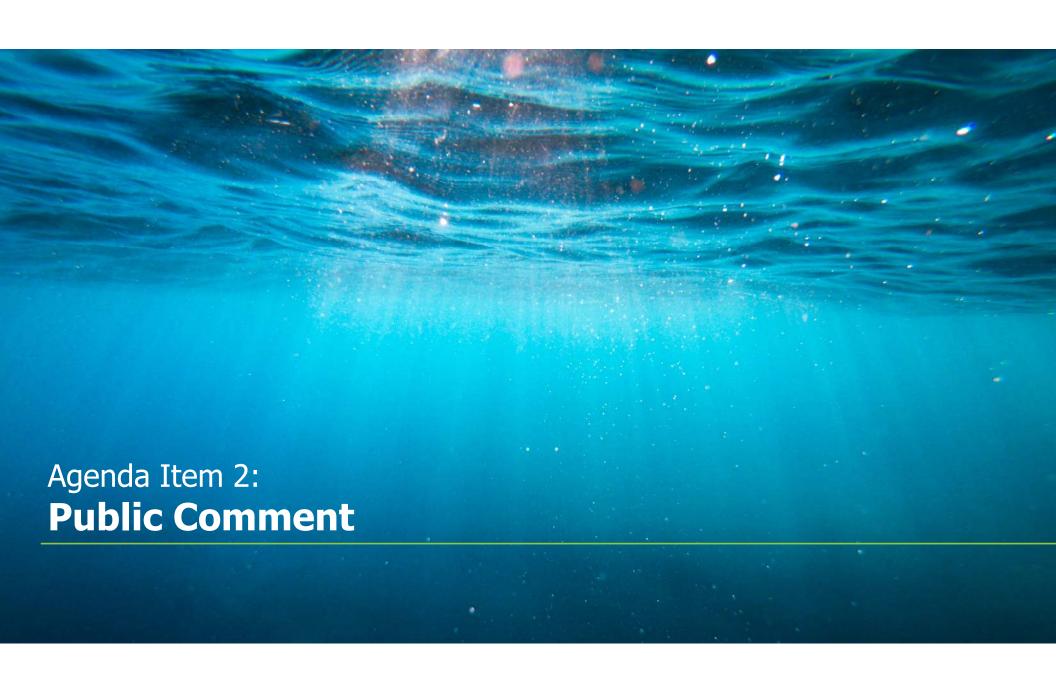


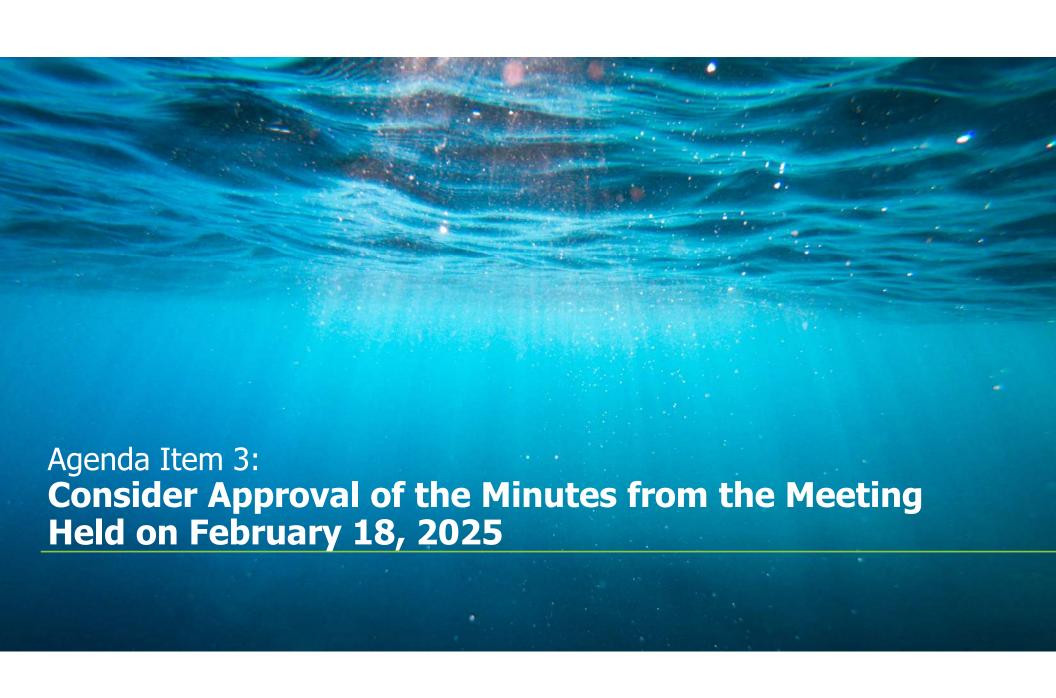
Pledge of Allegiance

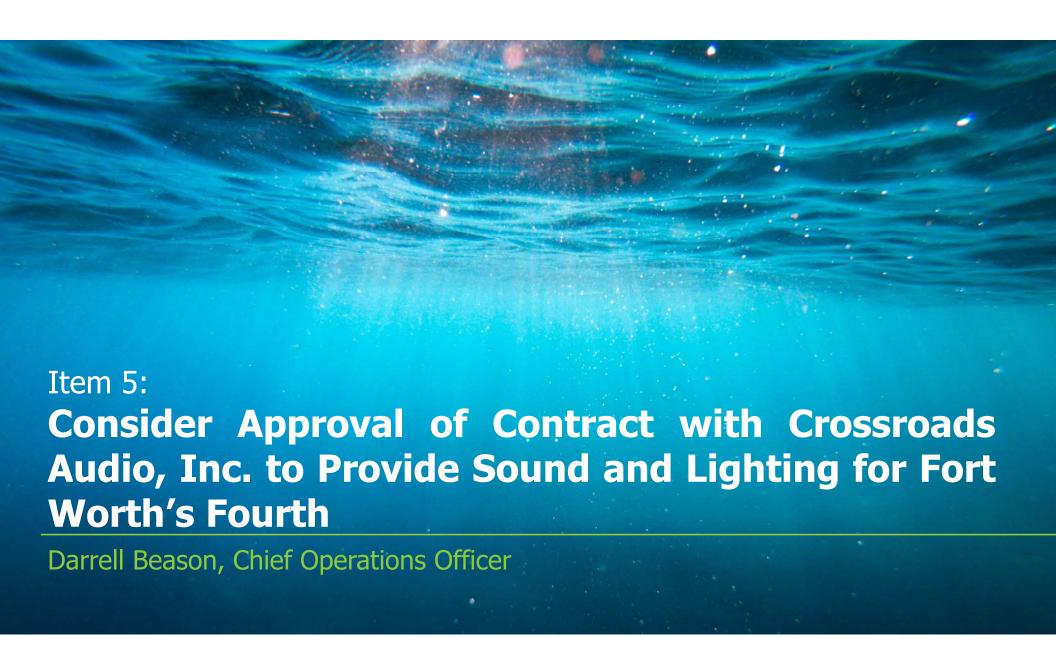
JCC1 138kV/4kV Electric Substation LP1 Electric Substation Same Configuration

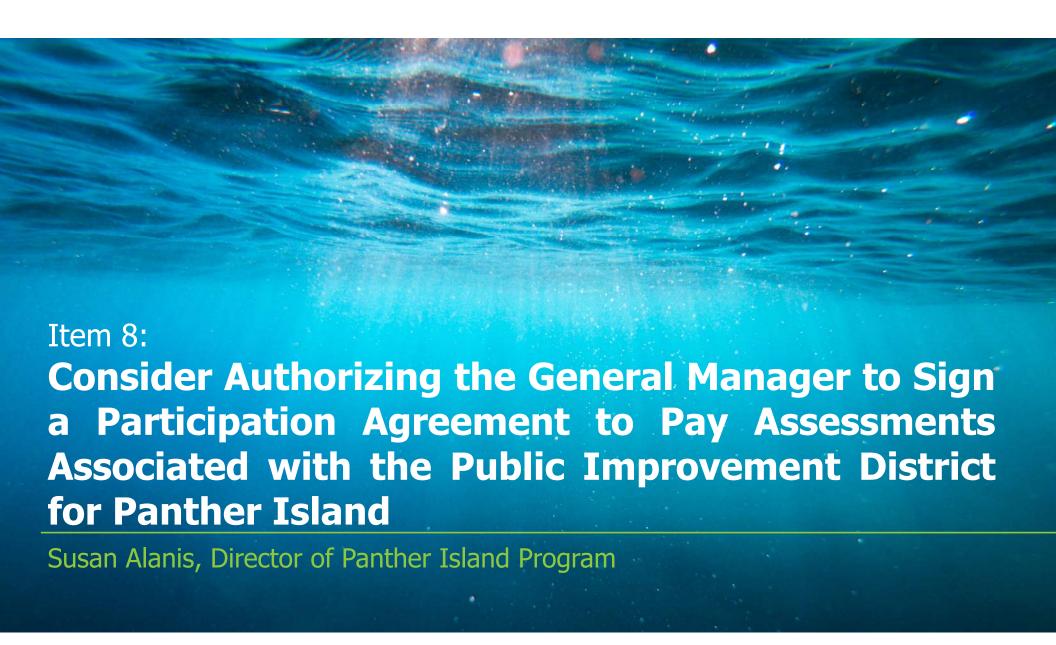

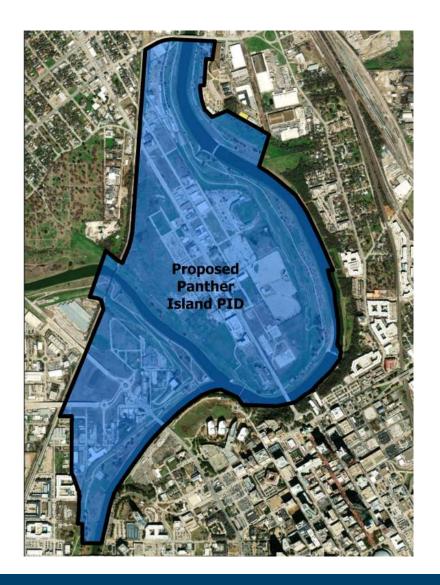


Update

- December 18, 2024: TRWD Board authorized General Manager to sign the <u>creation petition</u>
 - Referenced an anticipated Participation Agreement with voluntary assessment as a tax-exempt entity
- March 2025: City advised best legal option is inclusion of only private property owners as signators for creation petition, regardless of TRWD voluntary assessment
- Today's purpose:
 - Inform the TRWD Board of this process change
 - Request authorization for General Manager to sign <u>Participation Agreement</u> agreeing to TRWD assessment by PID

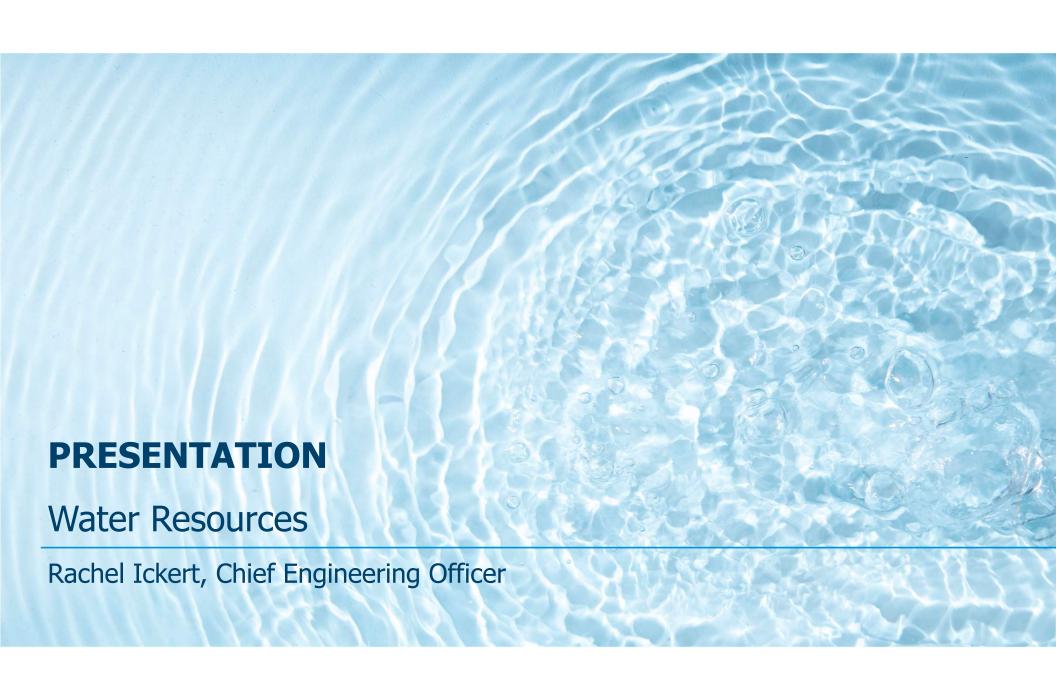

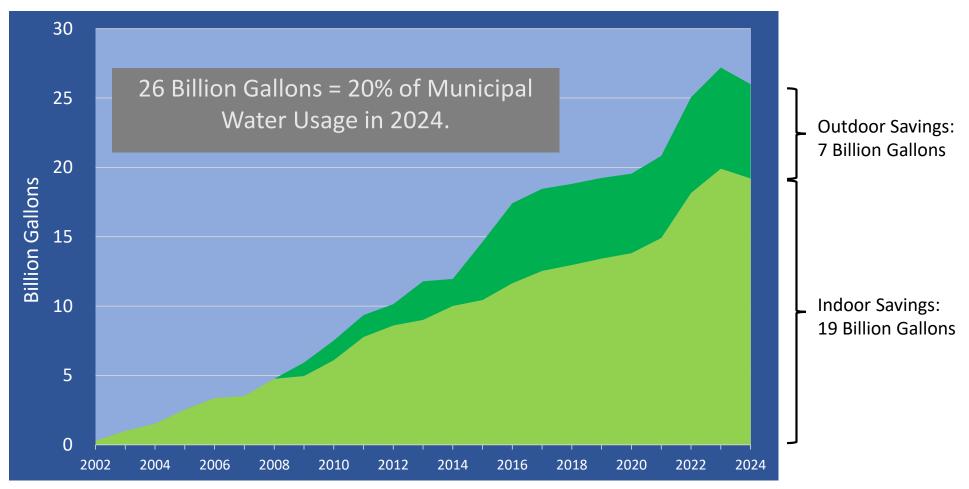

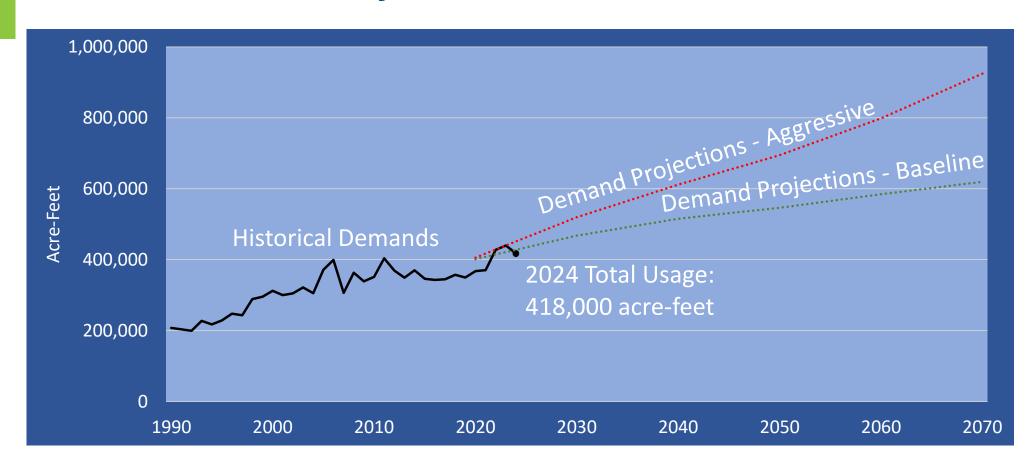


2024 Estimated Conservation Savings = 26 Billion Gallons



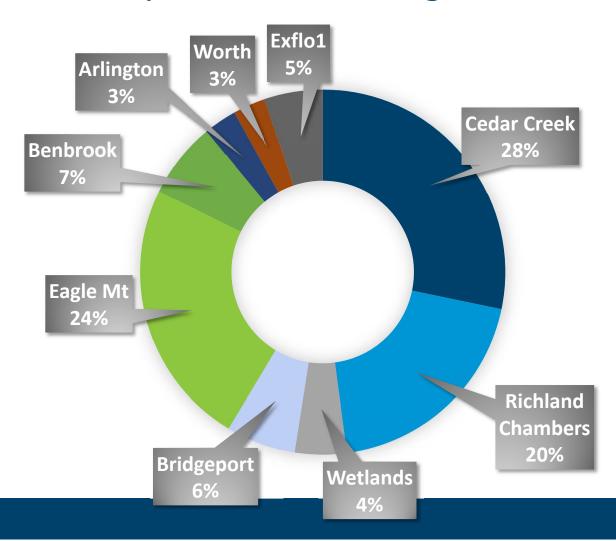


Historical Use and Projected Demands

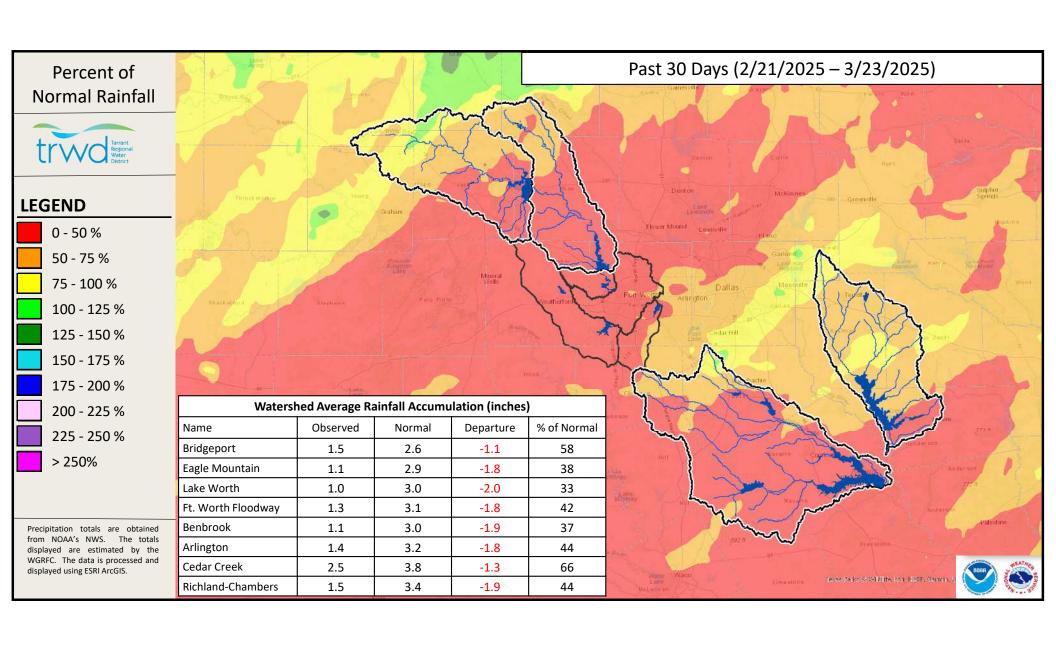

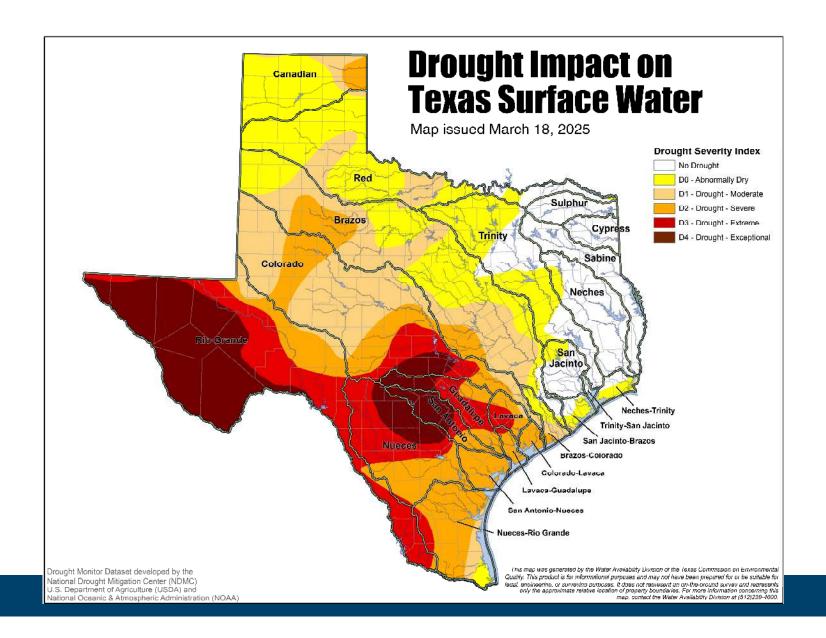
Regional Water Planning for 2027 State Water Plan

- Draft 2026 Regional Water Plans were submitted to TWDB this month.

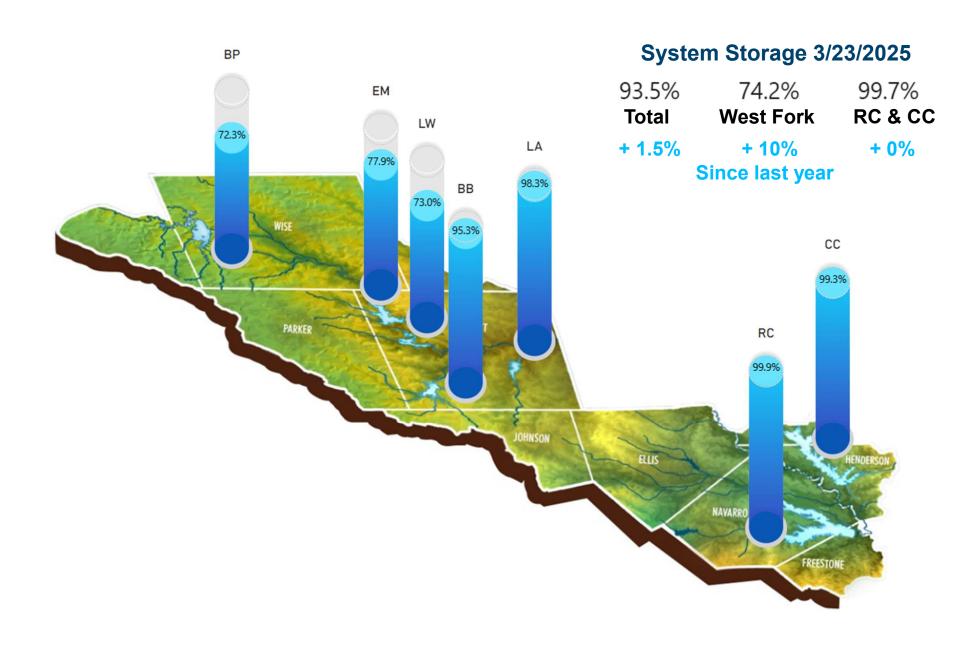

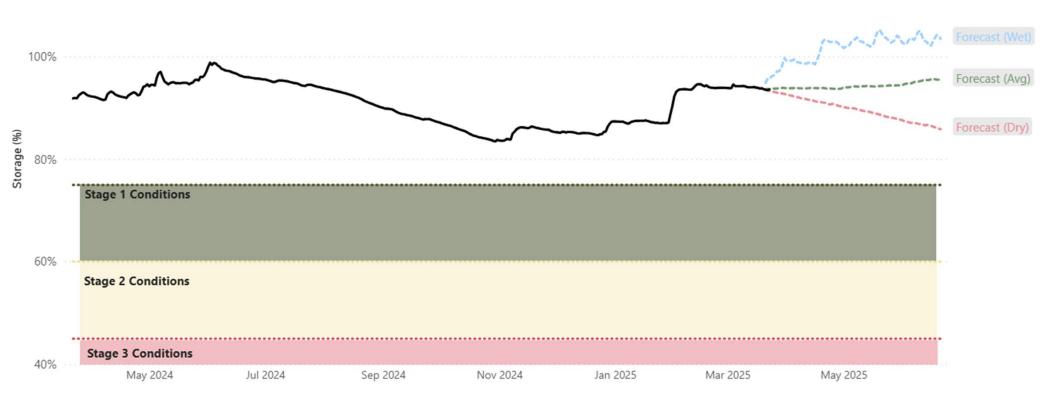




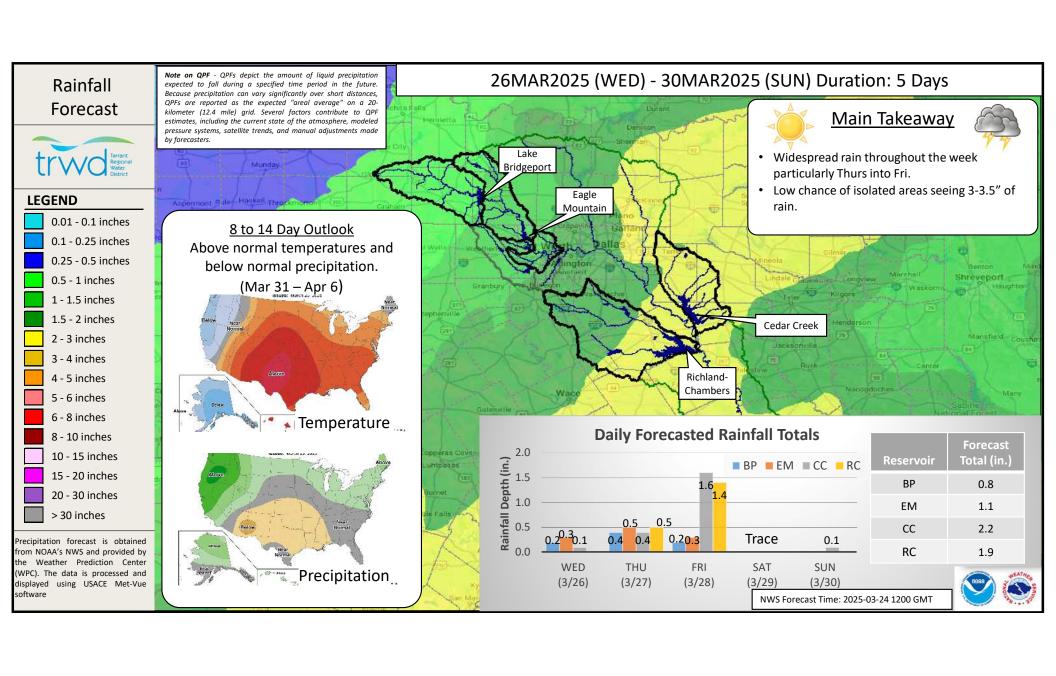


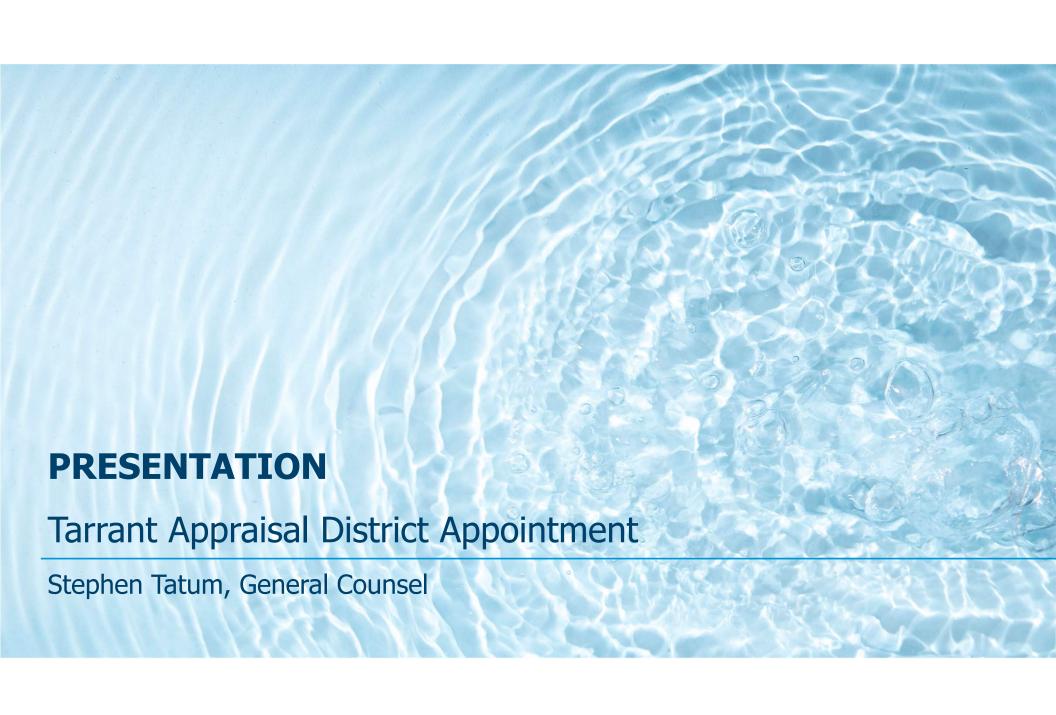


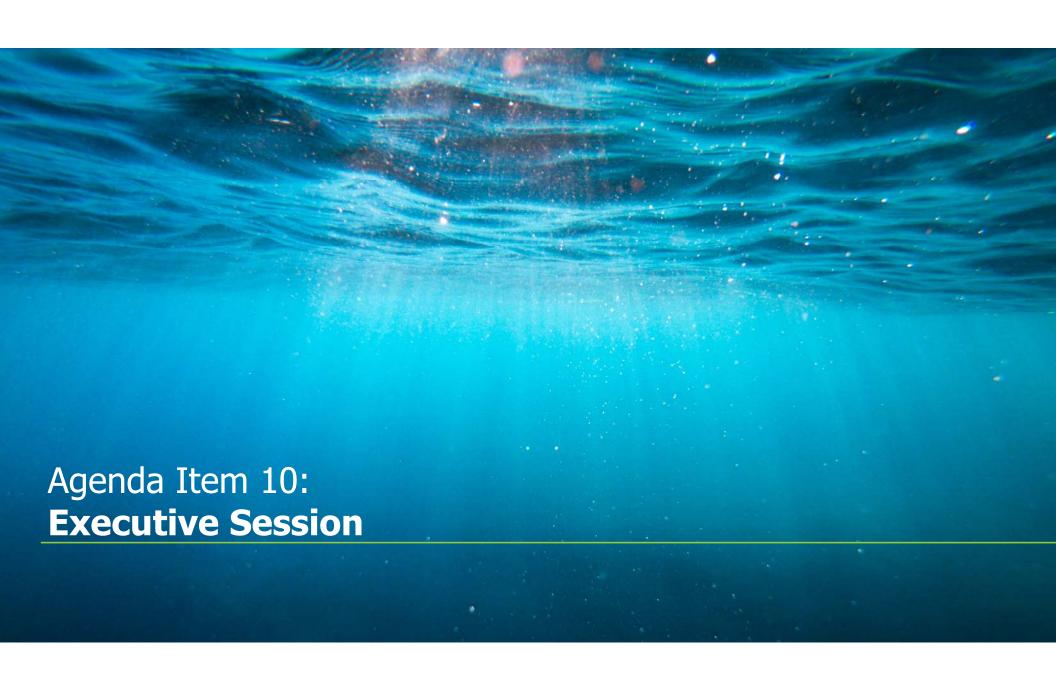
Historical and Projected Total Water Supply Storage



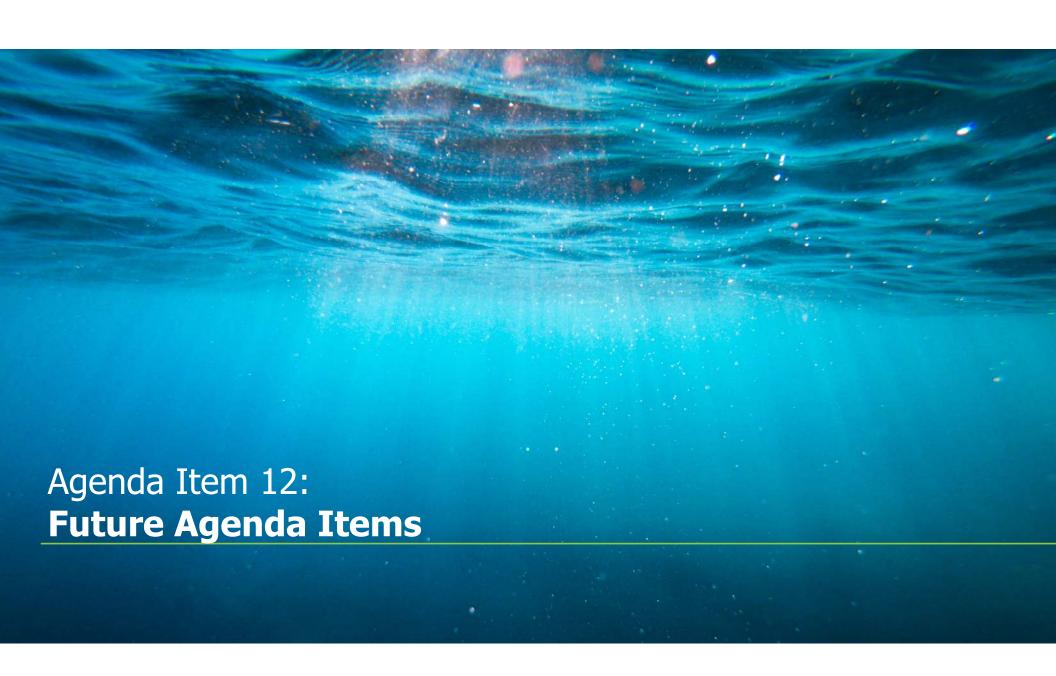


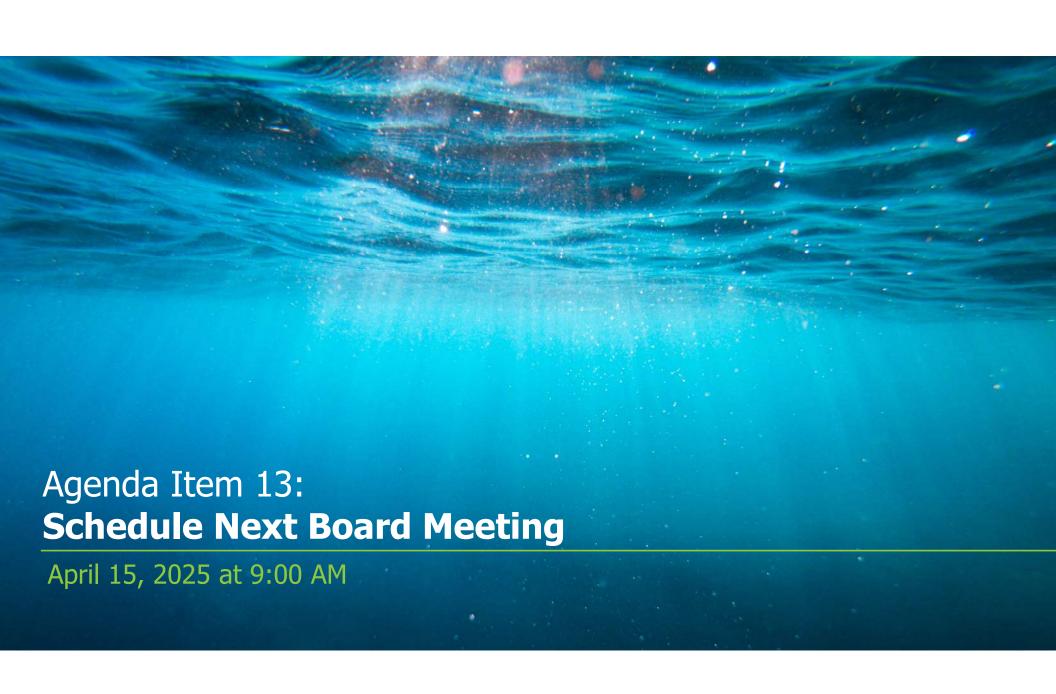


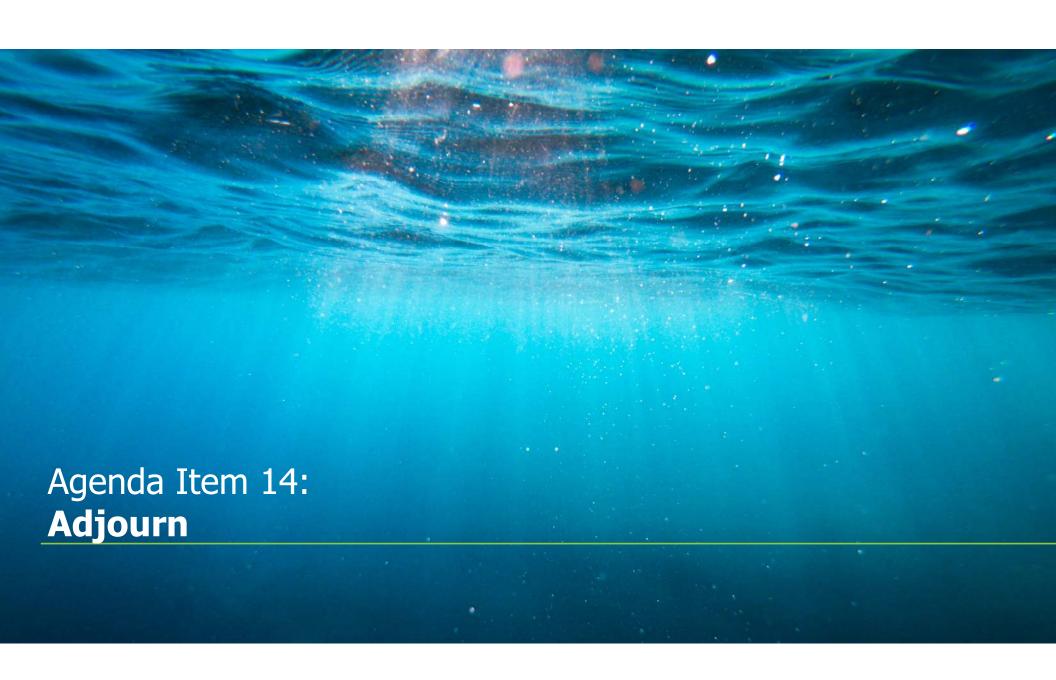
